HOUSE BILL NO. 487

1	AN	ACT	TO	AMEND	SECTION	71-3-51,	MISSISSIPPI	CODE	OF	1972,	. TO

- 2 PROVIDE THAT DECISIONS MADE BY THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION
- 3 COMMISSION MAY BE APPEALED DIRECTLY TO THE STATE SUPREME COURT;
- 4 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 71-3-51, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 71-3-51. The final award of the commission shall be
- 9 conclusive and binding unless either party to the controversy
- 10 shall, within thirty (30) days from the date of its filing in the
- 11 office of the commission and notification to the parties, appeal
- 12 therefrom to the <u>State Supreme Court</u>.
- 13 Such appeal may be taken by filing notice of appeal with the
- 14 commission, whereupon the commission shall under its certificate
- 15 transmit to the <u>State Supreme Court</u> all documents and papers on
- 16 file in the matter, together with a transcript of the evidence,
- 17 the findings, and award, which shall thereupon become the record
- 18 of the cause. Appeals shall be considered only upon the record as
- 19 made before the commission. The <u>State Supreme Court</u> shall always
- 20 be deemed open for hearing of such appeals, * * * and the same
- 21 shall have precedence over all civil cases except election
- 22 contests. The <u>State Supreme Court</u> shall review all questions of

- 23 law and of fact. If no prejudicial error be found, the matter
- 24 shall be affirmed and remanded to the commission for enforcement.
- 25 If prejudicial error be found, the same shall be reversed and the
- 26 <u>State Supreme Court</u> shall enter such judgment or award as the
- 27 commission should have entered. * * * An appeal from the
- 28 commission to the <u>State Supreme Court</u> shall not act as a
- 29 supersedeas unless the court * * * shall so direct, and then upon
- 30 such terms as such court shall direct.
- 31 No controversy shall be heard by the commission or an award
- 32 of compensation made therein while the same matter is pending
- 33 either before a federal court or in any court in this state.
- Any award of compensation made by the * * * Supreme Court
- 35 shall bear the same interest and penalties as do other judgments
- 36 awarded in the <u>Supreme Court</u>.
- 37 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 38 and after July 1, 2000.
