HOUSE BILL NO. 503

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 7-1-501 AND 7-1-503, MISSISSIPPI 2 CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY APPOINTMENTS OF COMMISSIONERS TO THE NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF COMMISSIONERS ON UNIFORM STATE LAWS; TO 3 4 AMEND SECTION 7-1-505, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY TO DESIGNATE A SUBSTITUTE TO ATTEND THE 5 CONFERENCE'S ANNUAL MEETING, IN THE EVENT THAT A COMMISSIONER OR 6 ASSOCIATE MEMBER IS UNABLE TO ATTEND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 9 SECTION 1. Section 7-1-501, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 10 amended as follows: 7-1-501. The commission on uniform state laws shall consist 11 12 of the following appointed commissioners to the National 13 Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws, all of whom shall be members, in good standing, of the Mississippi State Bar: 14 two (2) members of the bar appointed by the Governor; a member of 15 16 the Senate appointed by the Lieutenant Governor; a member of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House; 17 18 any member of the bar who has been elected a life member of the 19 conference; and the Directors of the Mississippi Law Research 20 Institute, and the Senate and House Legislative Services Offices. The commissioners so appointed shall confer and act with the 21 commissioners of other states and territories in the formulation 2.2 23 of uniform laws on all subjects. The commissioners shall prepare

Section 7-1-503, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 26 27 amended as follows: 7-1-503. Two (2) associate members of the National 28 29 Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws, all of whom 30 shall be members, in good standing, of the Mississippi State Bar, shall be appointed to act in accordance with the constitution and 31 bylaws of the conference as follows: 32 33 (a) The Lieutenant Governor shall appoint one (1) associate member from the \* \* \* staff of the Senate \* \* \*; and 34 35 (b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall 36 appoint one (1) associate member from the \* \* \* staff of the 37 House \* \* \*. \* \* \* 38 39 SECTION 3. Section 7-1-505, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 40 7-1-505. The commissioners and associate members shall serve 41 42 until such time as they are removed or their successors are appointed by the aforesaid appointing authorities. In the event 43 44 that a commissioner or associate member is unable to attend an 45 annual meeting of the conference, the appointing authority shall 46 designate a substitute person to attend the meeting. SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 47 and after its passage. 48
