HOUSE BILL NO. 553

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 75-76-129, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO REMOVE THE CAP ON THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF THE STATE'S SHARE OF
- 3 GAMING REVENUES THAT IS DIVERTED FOR USE BY THE MISSISSIPPI
- 4 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR CERTAIN GAMING COUNTIES
- 5 INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS; TO DELETE THE PROVISION THAT DIVERTS A
- 6 PORTION OF THE STATE'S SHARE OF GAMING REVENUES TO THE STATE
- 7 HIGHWAY FUND; TO DELETE THE JULY 1, 2012, DATE AFTER WHICH MONIES
- 8 FROM THE STATE'S SHARE OF GAMING REVENUES THAT IS DIVERTED TO THE
- 9 GAMING COUNTIES INFRASTRUCTURE FUND CEASES; AND FOR RELATED
- 10 PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 75-76-129, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 13 amended as follows:
- 14 * * *
- 15 75-76-129. On or before the last day of each month all
- 16 taxes, fees, interest, penalties, damages, fines or other monies
- 17 collected by the State Tax Commission during that month under the
- 18 provisions of this chapter, with the exception of (a) the local
- 19 government fees imposed under Section 75-76-195, and (b) * * * an
- 20 amount equal to twenty-five percent (25%) of the revenue collected
- 21 pursuant to the fee imposed under Section 75-65-177(1)(c), * * *
- 22 shall be paid by the State Tax Commission to the State Treasurer
- 23 to be deposited in the State General Fund. The local government
- 24 fees shall be distributed by the State Tax Commission pursuant to
- 25 Section 75-76-197. An amount equal to <u>twenty-five percent (25%)</u>

- of the revenue collected during that month pursuant to the fee
- 27 imposed under Section 75-76-177(1)(c) shall be deposited by the
- 28 State Tax Commission into the bond sinking fund created in Section
- 29 65-39-3. * * *

- 31 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 32 and after July 1, 2000.
