1	AN ACT T	O AMEND	SECTIONS	25 - 15 - 3	AND	25-15-13.	MISSISSIPPI

- 2 CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN RETIRED PUBLIC SCHOOL AND
- 3 STATE EMPLOYEES MAY ENROLL IN THE STATE AND SCHOOL EMPLOYEES LIFE
- 4 AND HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN DURING A ONE-YEAR OPEN ENROLLMENT
- 5 PERIOD; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 25-15-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 25-15-3. For the purposes of this article, the words and
- 10 phrases used herein shall have the following meanings:
- 11 (a) "Employee" means a person who works full time for
- 12 the State of Mississippi and receives his compensation in a direct
- 13 payment from a department, agency or institution of the State
- 14 Government and any person who works full time for any school
- 15 district, community/junior college, public library or
- 16 university-based program authorized under Section 37-23-31 for
- 17 deaf, aphasic and emotionally disturbed children or any regular
- 18 nonstudent bus driver. This shall include legislators, employees
- 19 of the legislative branch and the judicial branch of the state and
- 20 "employees" shall include full-time salaried judges and full-time
- 21 district attorneys and their staff and full-time compulsory school
- 22 attendance officers. For the purposes of this article, any

- 23 "employee" making contributions to the State of Mississippi
- 24 retirement plan shall be considered a full-time employee.
- 25 (b) "Department" means the Department of Finance and
- 26 Administration.
- (c) "Plan" means the State and School Employees Life 27
- 28 and Health Insurance Plan created under this article.
- 29 (d) "Fund" means the State and School Employees
- 30 Insurance Fund set up under this article.
- 31 "Retiree" means any employee retired under the
- Mississippi retirement plan, including those retired employees who 32
- enroll in the plan during the open enrollment period provided in 33
- Section 25-15-13. 34
- 35 "Board" means the State and School Employees Health
- 36 Insurance Management Board created under Section 25-15-303.
- SECTION 2. Section 25-15-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 37
- 38 amended as follows:
- 25-15-13. Each eligible employee may participate in the 39
- plan by signing up for the plan at the time of employment. Each 40
- eligible employee who declines coverage under the plan must sign a 41
- waiver of coverage. After acceptance in the plan, the employee 42
- 43 may cease his or her participation by filing a specific disclaimer
- with the board. Forms for this purpose shall be prescribed and 44
- 45 issued by the board. All eligible employees will be eligible to
- participate in the plan on the effective date of the plan or on 46
- the date on which they are employed by the state, whichever is 47
- later, provided they make the necessary contributions as provided 48
- 49 in this article. Spouses of employees, unmarried dependent
- 50 children from birth to age nineteen (19) years, unmarried
- 51 dependent children who are full-time students up to age
- 52 twenty-five (25) years, and physically or mentally handicapped
- 53 children, regardless of age, are eligible under the plan as of the

- 54 date the employee becomes eligible. If both spouses are eligible
- 55 employees who participate in the plan, the benefits shall apply
- 56 individually to each spouse by virtue of his or her participation
- 57 in the plan. If those spouses also have one or more eligible
- 58 dependents participating in the plan, the cost of their dependents
- 59 shall be calculated at a special family plan rate. The cost for
- 60 participation by the dependents shall be paid by the spouse who
- 61 elects to carry such dependents under his or her coverage. The
- 62 board shall provide for an open enrollment period beginning July
- 63 1, 2000, and ending July 1, 2001, for those employees who retired
- 64 <u>before April 12, 1991.</u>
- 65 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 66 and after July 1, 2000.
