HOUSE BILL NO. 588

- 1 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT SMOKING IN NEW CAPITOL BUILDING; TO
- 2 PROVIDE THAT THIS ACT SHALL BE ENFORCED BY THE CAPITOL POLICE AND
- 3 THE SERGEANTS AT ARMS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE
- 4 SENATE; TO PROVIDE CIVIL PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ACT; AND
- 5 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, the term "smoke" or
- 8 "smoking" means to inhale, exhale, burn, carry or otherwise
- 9 possess any lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe or any other object or
- 10 device of any form that contains lighted tobacco or any other
- 11 smoking product.
- 12 (2) No person shall smoke in the New Capitol Building.
- 13 (3) The Capitol Police and the Sergeants at Arms of the
- 14 House of Representatives and the Senate shall not permit smoking
- 15 in the New Capitol Building and shall use reasonable efforts to
- 16 prevent smoking in the New Capitol Building, including, but not
- 17 limited to, the following:
- 18 (a) Posting appropriate signs informing state
- 19 employees, invitees, guests and other persons that smoking is
- 20 prohibited in the New Capitol Building; and
- 21 (b) Securing the removal of persons who smoke in the
- 22 New Capitol Building.

- 23 (4) Any person who violates subsection (2) of this section
- 24 shall be subject to a civil penalty of not more than One Hundred
- 25 Dollars (\$100.00) for each violation.
- 26 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 27 and after July 1, 2000.
