- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-17-59, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO INCREASE THE PENALTIES FOR TIMBER THEFT; AND FOR RELATED
- 3 PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 97-17-59, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:[BD1]
- 7 97-17-59. (1) Any person who shall knowingly, willfully and
- 8 feloniously take, steal and carry away from the lands of another
- 9 any merchantable timber on the property of another, of the value
- 10 of less than <u>Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00)</u>, whether such
- 11 timber <u>is</u> growing, standing or lying on <u>the</u> lands, shall be guilty
- of a misdemeanor; and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished
- 13 by a fine of not less than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) nor more
- 14 than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment in the
- 15 county jail for a term of not less than thirty (30) days nor more
- 16 than one hundred (100) days, or both, in the discretion of the
- 17 court.
- 18 (2) Any person who shall knowingly, willfully and
- 19 feloniously take, steal and carry away from the lands of another
- 20 any merchantable timber on the property of another, of the value
- of <u>Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00)</u> or more, whether such

- 22 timber <u>is</u> growing, standing, or lying on <u>the</u> lands, shall be
- 23 guilty of a felony; and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished
- 24 by a fine of not less than <a>One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) nor
- 25 more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by imprisonment in
- 26 the Penitentiary for a term of not less than one (1) year nor more
- 27 than five (5) years, or both, in the discretion of the court.
- 28 (3) An individual, upon conviction, shall be subject to
- 29 paying restitution to the victim in the amount determined by the
- 30 court.
- 31 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 32 and after July 1, 2000.
