1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-17-59, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE PENALTIES FOR TIMBER THEFT; AND FOR RELATED 2 3 PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 97-17-59, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows:[BD1] 7 97-17-59. (1) Any person who shall knowingly, willfully and 8 feloniously take, steal and carry away from the lands of another 9 any merchantable timber on the property of another, of the value of less than <u>Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00)</u>, whether such 10 timber is growing, standing or lying on the lands, shall be guilty 11 12 of a misdemeanor; and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished 13 by a fine of not less than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment in the 14 county jail for a term of not less than thirty (30) days nor more 15 than one hundred (100) days, or both, in the discretion of the 16 court. 17 Any person who shall knowingly, willfully and (2)

- 31 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
