HOUSE BILL NO. 599

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI NATIONAL
GUARD FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A NEW NATIONAL GUARD ARMORY
IN OXFORD, MISSISSIPPI, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2001.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be 6 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General 7 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi National Guard for the purpose of constructing a new national guard armory in 8 Oxford, Mississippi, and to authorize the use of part of the funds 9 10 to match any federal funds that may be available to the state for armory construction, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, 11 and ending June 30, 2001..... \$1,650,000.00. 12

13 SECTION 2. The acceptance and expenditure of federal 14 government funds which may become available to the Mississippi 15 National Guard for construction purposes is authorized and 16 approved, provided the receipts and expenditures are reported and 17 otherwise handled in accordance with the State Budget Law, which 18 is Section 27-103-101 et seq. and Section 27-104-1 et seq.,

20 SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much of it as may be 21 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the special fund in

27 SECTION 4. The money appropriated under the provisions of 28 Section 1 shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, and the money 29 appropriated under the provisions of Section 3 shall be paid by 30 the State Treasurer out of the special fund to the credit of the 31 Mississippi National Guard, upon warrants issued by the State 32 Fiscal Officer, and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his 33 34 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or 35 officers in the manner provided by law.

36 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 37 and after July 1, 2000.
