HOUSE BILL NO. 641 (As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT TO CODIFY SECTIONS 97-32-25, 97-32-27 AND 97-32-29, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF TOBACCO BY ADULTS ON <u>CERTAIN</u> SCHOOL PROPERTY AND TO PRESCRIBE FINES FOR VIOLATIONS 2 3 THEREOF; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. The following provision shall be codified as Section 97-32-25, Mississippi Code of 1972: 7 <u>97-32-25.</u> This act shall be known and cited as "Mississippi 8 Adult Tobacco Use on Educational Property Act of 2000." 9 10 SECTION 2. The following provision shall be codified as Section 97-32-27, Mississippi Code of 1972: 11 <u>97-32-27.</u> (1) "Adult" means any natural person, age 12 eighteen (18) years old. 13 "Minor" means any natural person under the age of 14 (2) 15 eighteen (18) years old. "Person" means any natural person. 16 (3) "Tobacco product" means any substance that contains 17 (4) tobacco including, but not limited to, cigarettes, cigars, pipes, 18 19 snuff, smoking tobacco or smokeless tobacco. 20 (5) "School property" means any public or private school 21 building or bus, public or private school campus, grounds, recreational area, athletic field, or other property owned, used 22 or operated by any local school board, school, or directors for 23 24 the administration of any public or private educational 25 institution or during a school-related activity; provided, however, that the term "school property" shall not include any 26 sixteenth section school land. School property shall not include 27

30 SECTION 3. The following provision shall be codified as
31 Section 97-32-29, Mississippi Code of 1972:

32 <u>97-32-29.</u> No person shall use any tobacco product on any school property as defined in Section 2 of this act. Any adult 33 34 who violates this section shall be subject to a fine and shall be liable as follows: (a) for a first conviction, a fine of Fifty 35 36 Dollars (\$50.00); (b) for a second conviction, fine of Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00); and (c) for all subsequent 37 convictions, a fine of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) shall 38 39 be imposed.

Any adult found in violation of this section shall be issued a citation by the law enforcement agency issuing the citation. Notification shall include the opportunity for hearing before the appropriate court. For the purposes of this section, "subsequent violations" are those committed on any educational property within the State of Mississippi.

It is the responsibility of all law enforcement officers and law enforcement agencies of this state to ensure that the provisions of this act are enforced.

49 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 50 and after July 1, 2000.
