HOUSE BILL NO. 647

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 21-3-15, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE MAYORS OF MUNICIPALITIES OPERATING UNDER THE

3 MAYOR-ALDERMEN FORM OF GOVERNMENT TO SUSPEND EMPLOYEES WITH OR

WITHOUT PAY AFTER AUTHORIZATION FROM THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN; AND

5 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 21-3-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 21-3-15. (1) The mayor shall preside at all meetings of the
- 10 board of aldermen, and in case there shall be an equal division,
- 11 he shall give the deciding vote. He shall have the superintending
- 12 control of all the officers and affairs of the municipality, and
- 13 shall take care that the laws and ordinances are executed. The
- 14 mayor, after authorization from the board of aldermen, may suspend
- 15 <u>municipal employees with or without compensation for such period</u>
- of time as the mayor determines to be necessary.
- 17 (2) Ordinances adopted by the board of aldermen shall be
- 18 submitted to the mayor. The mayor shall, within ten (10) days
- 19 after receiving any ordinance, either approve the ordinance by
- 20 affixing his signature thereto, or return it to the board of
- 21 aldermen by delivering it to the municipal clerk together with a
- 22 written statement setting forth his objections thereto or to any
- 23 item or part thereof. No ordinance or any item or part thereof
- 24 shall take effect without the mayor's approval, unless the mayor
- 25 fails to return an ordinance to the board of aldermen prior to the
- 26 next meeting of the board, but no later than fifteen (15) days
- 27 after it has been presented to him, or unless the board of

- 28 aldermen, upon reconsideration thereof on or after the third day
- 29 following its return by the mayor, shall, by a vote of two-thirds
- 30 (2/3) of the members of the board, resolve to override the mayor's
- 31 veto.
- 32 (3) The <u>following words when used in this section shall have</u>
- 33 <u>the following meaning:</u>
- 34 <u>(a)</u> "Ordinance" * * * includes ordinances, resolutions
- 35 and orders.
- 36 (b) "Employee" means a person who works full or part
- 37 <u>time for the municipality</u>.
- 38 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 39 and after July 1, 2000.
