HOUSE BILL NO. 676

1 2	AN ACT TO CREATE A COMMISSION TO RECOMMEND THE DESIGN FOR A NEW STATE FLAG; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
4	SECTION 1. (1) There is established a commission to
5	recommend the design for a new Mississippi flag that will reflect
6	the diversity of the population.
7	(2) The commission shall consist of the following twelve
8	(12) members:
9	(a) Four (4) members appointed by the Governor of the
10	State of Mississippi who are representatives of the general public
11	and who are knowledgeable in Mississippi history;
12	(b) The President Pro Tempore of the Mississippi
13	Senate;
14	(c) The Speaker Pro Tempore of the Mississippi House of
15	Representatives;
16	(d) Three (3) members appointed by the Lieutenant
17	Governor of the State of Mississippi as follows:

(i) A member of the Mississippi Senate; and

(ii) Two (2) members of the general public; and

(e) Three (3) members appointed by the Speaker of the

Mississippi House of Representatives as follows:

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22 (i) One (1) member of the Mississippi House of

23 Representatives; and

- 24 (ii) Two (2) members of the general public.
- 25 (3) The appointments shall be made by September 1, 2000.
- 26 Within fifteen (15) days thereafter, on a day to be designated
- 27 jointly by the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor and the Speaker
- 28 of the House, the commission shall meet and organize by selecting
- 29 from its membership a chairman and a vice chairman. The vice
- 30 chairman also shall serve as secretary and shall be responsible
- 31 for keeping all records of the commission. The commission shall
- 32 meet no more than once per month. A majority of the members of
- 33 the commission shall constitute a quorum at all meetings. An
- 34 affirmative vote of a majority of the members present and voting
- 35 shall be required in the adoption of any actions taken by the
- 36 commission. All members shall be notified in writing of all
- 37 regular and special meetings of the commission, which notices
- 38 shall be mailed at least ten (10) days before the dates of the
- 39 meetings. All meetings shall take place at the State Capitol in
- 40 Jackson, Mississippi.
- 41 (4) Members of the commission shall not receive
- 42 compensation. However, each member may be paid travel expenses
- 43 and meals and lodging expenses as provided in Section 25-3-41, for
- 44 such expenses incurred in furtherance of their duties. Travel
- 45 expenses and meals and lodging expenses and other necessary
- 46 expenses incurred by the commission shall be paid out of funds
- 47 appropriated to the Governor's Office.
- 48 (5) In carrying out the provisions of this act, the
- 49 commission may utilize the services, facilities and personnel of
- 50 all departments, agencies, offices and institutions of the state.
- 51 (6) The commission shall file its report and recommendations
- 52 for the design of the new Mississippi flag with the Secretary of

- 53 the Senate and the Clerk of the House not later than January 1,
- 54 2001. The commission shall be dissolved once the recommendation
- 55 is filed.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 57 and after July 1, 2000.
