HOUSE BILL NO. 762 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF FULTON, MISSISSIPPI, TO 1 2 ACQUIRE AND ASSUME THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE NORTH CLAY 3 WATER ASSOCIATION AND TO ASSUME ALL THE LIABILITIES, OBLIGATIONS, 4 ASSETS, DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF SUCH ASSOCIATION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF FULTON TO OPERATE ITS WATER DISTRIBUTION 5 SYSTEM FOR A DISTANCE OF MORE THAN FIVE MILES FROM THE CORPORATE 6 7 LIMITS OF THE CITY OF FULTON IN ORDER TO OPERATE THE WATER SYSTEM 8 WITHIN THE AREA PRESENTLY SERVED BY THE NORTH CLAY WATER 9 ASSOCIATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 SECTION 1. (1) The governing authorities of the City of Fulton, Mississippi, in their discretion, may acquire and assume 12 the operation and maintenance of the water distribution systems 13 owned by North Clay Water Association; and, in connection 14 15 therewith, the governing authorities of the City of Fulton may 16 assume all liabilities, including the Farmers Home Administration 17 (FHA) indebtedness outstanding on the effective date of House Bill 18 No. 762, 2000 Regular Session, obligations, assets, duties and responsibilities of the association. The city shall have such 19 powers and authority concerning the association and its facilities 20 as is granted by law to municipalities concerning water systems. 21 (2) Any indebtedness incurred by the City of Fulton as a 22 23 result of the exercise of the authority granted under subsection (1) of this section shall not constitute a debt within the meaning 2.4 25 of any statutory limitation as to the amount of debt which may be incurred by the municipality. 26 27 SECTION 2. (1) (a) Notwithstanding any provisions of

28 Section 21-27-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, to the contrary, the 29 governing authorities of the City of Fulton, Mississippi, in their

No. 762 00\HR07\R722 PAGE 1 30 discretion, may construct, expand, operate and maintain the water distribution system of the City of Fulton for a distance of more 31 than five (5) miles from the corporate limits of the City of 32 33 Fulton in order to operate the water system within the area 34 served by North Clay Water Association on the effective date of House Bill No. 762, 2000 Regular Session. The rate charged to 35 consumers of water service furnished by the water system who 36 reside outside the corporate limits of the City of Fulton shall be 37 no greater than twice the rate charged to consumers who reside 38 within the corporate limits of the city, until the provisions of 39 40 paragraph (b) are applicable.

(b) Upon the completion of any construction, expansion or improvement of the water system and the retirement of any indebtedness incurred in connection therewith, the consumers of water service furnished by the water distribution system who reside outside the corporate limits of the City of Fulton shall be charged the same rate as that charged to consumers who reside within the corporate limits of the city.

48 (2) The authority conferred by this section shall not be 49 construed as an exemption to Chapter 3, Title 77, Mississippi Code 50 of 1972, concerning the requirements of obtaining a Certificate of 51 Public Convenience and Necessity, the jurisdiction of the Public 52 Service Commission to regulate rates or any other provision of law 53 related to the regulation of public utilities.

54 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 55 and after its passage.
