- 2 TO CREATE A REBUTTABLE PRESUMPTION THAT THE OWNER OF A MOTOR
- 3 VEHICLE THAT PASSES A SCHOOL BUS ILLEGALLY IS THE DRIVER OF THE
- 4 MOTOR VEHICLE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 63-3-615, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:[HS1]
- 8 63-3-615. (1) The driver of a vehicle upon a street or
- 9 highway upon meeting or overtaking any school bus which has
- 10 stopped on the street or highway for the purpose of receiving or
- 11 discharging any school children shall come to a complete stop and
- 12 shall not proceed until the children have crossed the street or
- 13 highway and the school bus has proceeded in the direction it was
- 14 going. If the driver of the bus records the tag number of a motor
- 15 <u>vehicle</u> who violates this section and provides such information to
- 16 an enforcement officer, there shall be a rebuttable presumption
- 17 that the owner of the motor vehicle is the driver of such motor
- 18 <u>vehicle</u>.
- 19 (2) Any person violating the provisions of subsection (1) of
- 20 this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction
- 21 thereof shall be fined not less than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)
- 22 nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or imprisoned for

- 23 not more than one (1) year, or both.
- 24 (3) This section shall be applicable only in the event the
- 25 school bus shall bear upon the front and rear thereon a plainly
- 26 visible sign containing the words "school bus" in letters not less
- 27 than four (4) inches in height.
- 28 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 29 and after July 1, 2000.
