HOUSE BILL NO. 794

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 2, CHAPTER 447, LAWS OF 1999, TO 1 2 REVISE THE DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT CONTAINED IN SUCH LAW IN ORDER TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION OF TWO ADDITIONAL LANES FOR 3 4 TRAFFIC ACROSS THE ROSS BARNETT RESERVOIR DAM IN HINDS, MADISON AND RANKIN COUNTIES ADJACENT TO SPILLWAY ROAD; TO AMEND SECTION 3, 5 CHAPTER 447, LAWS OF 1999, TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF STATE GENERAL 6 OBLIGATION BONDS AUTHORIZED TO BE ISSUED IN SUCH LAW FROM 7 8 \$3,500,000.00 TO \$4,950,000.00; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 10 SECTION 1. Section 2, Chapter 447, Laws of 1999, is amended

11 as follows:

Section 2. A special fund, to be designated the "1999 12 Spillway Road Improvement Fund, " is created within the State 13 14 Treasury. The fund shall be maintained by the State Treasurer as 15 a separate and special fund, separate and apart from the General 16 Fund of the state, and investment earnings on amounts in the fund shall be deposited into such fund. The expenditure of monies 17 deposited into the fund shall be under the direction of the 18 19 Department of Finance and Administration, and such funds shall be 20 paid by the State Treasurer upon warrants issued by the Department 21 of Finance and Administration. Monies deposited into such fund 22 shall be disbursed to the Pearl River Valley Water Supply District 23 to pay the cost of constructing two (2) additional lanes for 24 traffic across the Ross Barnett Reservoir Dam in Hinds, Madison

H. B. No. 794 00\HR07\R1258 PAGE 1 and Rankin Counties <u>adjacent to Spillway Road</u>; to pay the cost of planning such project; to pay the cost of necessary signaling devices; <u>to pay the cost of lighting</u>; and to pay any other necessary costs of such project.

29 SECTION 2. Section 3, Chapter 447, Laws of 1999, is amended 30 as follows:

31 Section 3. (1) Upon recommendation of the Board of Directors of the Pearl River Valley Water Supply District, the 32 33 Department of Finance and Administration, at one time or from time to time, may declare by resolution the necessity for issuance of 34 general obligation bonds of the State of Mississippi to provide 35 funds for all costs incurred or to be incurred for the purposes 36 37 described in Section 2 of this act. Upon the adoption of a 38 resolution by the Department of Finance and Administration declaring the necessity for the issuance of any part or all of the 39 40 general obligation bonds authorized by this section, the Department of Finance and Administration shall deliver a certified 41 copy of its resolution or resolutions to the State Bond 42 Commission. Upon receipt of such resolution the commission, in 43 44 its discretion, may act as the issuing agent, prescribe the form 45 of the bonds, advertise for and accept bids, issue and sell the bonds so authorized to be sold, and do any and all other things 46 47 necessary and advisable in connection with the issuance and sale of such bonds. The amount of bonds issued under this act shall 48 not exceed Four Million Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars 49 50 <u>(\$4,950,000.00)</u>.

(2) Any investment earnings on amounts deposited into the S2 1999 Spillway Road Improvement Fund created in Section 2 of this act shall be used to pay debt service on bonds issued under this act, in accordance with the proceedings authorizing issuance of such bonds.

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(3) Upon the completion or abandonment of the projects 56 described in Section 2 of this act, as evidenced by a resolution 57 58 adopted by the Department of Finance and Administration certifying that all such projects have been completed or abandoned, the 59 60 balance, if any, remaining in the 1999 Spillway Road Improvement Fund shall be promptly applied to pay debt service on bonds issued 61 under this act, in accordance with the proceedings authorizing the 62 63 issuance of such bonds.

64 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 65 and after its passage.
