The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 8 necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State 9 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of 10 Finance and Administration, acting through the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property Management, for the purpose of 11 reauthorizing the expenditure of State General Funds, as 12 13 authorized in Senate Bill No. 3199, Regular Session of 1995, 14 Senate Bill No. 2503, Regular Session of 1996, Senate Bill No. 2427, Regular Session of 1997, House Bill No. 1684, Regular 15 Session of 1998, and House Bill No. 1331, Regular Session of 1999, 16 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 17 2001.....\$ 869,135.00 18 This reappropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorizing 19 the expenditure of State General Funds for renovating and/or 20 21 repairing existing state-owned facilities and for purchasing and/or replacing furniture and equipment for all institutions, 22 agencies and departments of the State of Mississippi. 23 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the 2.4 provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended 25 exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2000, or change the 26 27 purpose for which the funds were originally authorized.

The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 29 necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State 30 Treasury to the credit of Fund No. 3931, to the Department of Finance and Administration, acting through the Bureau of Building, 31 32 Grounds and Real Property Management, for the purpose of 33 reauthorizing the expenditure of funds previously appropriated for 34 construction and/or repair and renovation projects at various state agencies and institutions, for the fiscal year beginning 35 July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001..... 36 37\$ 31,012,344.00. This reappropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorizing 38 39 the expenditure of special funds for construction and/or repair 40 and renovation projects at various state agencies and institutions 41 that had been authorized by the Legislature in prior fiscal years. Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the 42 43 provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended 44 exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2000, or change the 45 purpose for which the funds were originally authorized. 46 SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 47 necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State 48 Treasury to the credit of the Education Enhancement Fund No. 4900, to the Department of Finance and Administration, acting through 49 the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property Management, for 50 the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of funds previously 51 appropriated for construction and/or repair and renovation 52 53 projects at various state agencies and institutions, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001 54 55 787,193.00. This reappropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorizing 56 57 the expenditure of special funds for construction and/or repair 58 and renovation projects at various state agencies and institutions that had been authorized by the Legislature in prior fiscal years. 59 60 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the

54 SECTION 4. The Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property 55 Management of the Office of General Services is hereby expressly 56 authorized and empowered to receive, budget and expend any state, 57 local or other source funds designated for supplemental funding of 58 construction and/or repair and renovation projects.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 69 70 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 71 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 72 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 73 74 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 75 76 and after July 1, 2001.
