8	83-17-11. (1) For violation of Sections 83-17-7 to
9	83-17-15, the commissioner shall have the authority to revoke the
0	license of the agent or company violating same, for not less than

- 11 three (3) nor more than six (6) months for the first offense, and
- for one (1) year for the second offense. 12
- 13 (2) In lieu of, or in addition to, the revocations provided
- for in subsection (1) of this section, the commissioner may fine 14
- the company or the agent, or both, for violations of Sections 15
- 83-17-1 through 83-17-15. Any fines levied against the agent or 16
- companies, or both, shall be up to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) 17
- for each policy sold or transaction negotiated by an unlicensed 18
- agent. The funds from such fines shall be deposited into the 19
- 20 special fund in the State Treasury designated as the "Insurance
- Department Fund." 21

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- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 22
- and after July 1, 2000. 23
