HOUSE BILL NO. 852

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 83-17-11, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE TO IMPOSE FINES ON 3 COMPANIES WHO USE UNLICENSED AGENTS OR ON UNLICENSED AGENTS, OR 4 BOTH; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 83-17-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:[HS1] 7 83-17-11. (1) For violation of Sections 83-17-7 to 8 83-17-15, the commissioner shall have the authority to revoke the 9 10 license of the agent or company violating same, for not less than three (3) nor more than six (6) months for the first offense, and 11 for one (1) year for the second offense. 12 13 (2) In lieu of, or in addition to, the revocations provided for in subsection (1) of this section, the commissioner may fine 14 15 the company or the agent, or both, for violations of Sections 83-17-1 through 83-17-15. Any fines levied against the agent or 16 companies, or both, shall be Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for 17 each policy sold or transaction negotiated by an unlicensed agent. 18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 19

20 and after July 1, 2000.
