HOUSE BILL NO. 882

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-7-61, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 2 PROVIDE THAT ALL JURORS WHO APPEAR FOR JURY DUTY SHALL RECEIVE 3 FULL COMPENSATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 25-7-61, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 6 7 25-7-61. (1) Fees of jurors shall be payable as follows: 8 (a) Grand jurors and petit jurors in the chancery, county, circuit and special eminent domain courts shall be paid an 9 10 amount to be set by the board of supervisors, not to be less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per day and not to be greater than 11 Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per day, plus mileage authorized in Section 12 25-3-41. In the trial of all cases where jurors are in charge of 13 bailiffs and are not permitted to separate, the sheriff with the 14 15 approval of the trial judge may pay for room and board of jurors on panel for actual time of trial. 16 17 All jurors who appear shall receive * * * compensation as provided by this section. 18 (b) Jurors making inquisitions of idiocy, lunacy or of 19

20 unsound mind and jurors on coroner's inquest shall be paid Five
21 Dollars (\$5.00) per day plus mileage authorized in Section 25-3-41

25 (c) Jurors in the justice courts shall be paid an amount of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per day and not more 26 27 than Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per day, to be established by the 28 board of supervisors. In all criminal cases in the justice court wherein the prosecution fails, the fees of jurors shall be paid by 29 the county treasurer on order of the board of supervisors on 30 certificate of the county attorney in all counties that have 31 county attorneys, otherwise by the justice court judge. 32

33 (2) Any juror may return the fees provided as compensation 34 for service as a juror to the county which paid for such person's 35 service as a juror. The fees returned to the county may be 36 earmarked for a particular purpose to be selected by the juror, 37 including:

(a) The local public library;

39 (b) Local law enforcement;

40 (c) The Mississippi Fire Fighters Memorial Burn Center
41 fund created in Section 7-9-70, Mississippi Code of 1972; or

42 (d) Any other governmental agency.

43 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 44 and after July 1, 2000.
