Section 19-5-319, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:[LH1] 19-5-319. * * * Automatic number identification (ANI), 8 automatic location identification (ALI) and geographic automatic 9 10 location identification (GeoALI) information that consist of the name, address and telephone number of telephone or wireless 11 subscribers shall be confidential, and the dissemination of the 12 13 information contained in the 911 automatic number and location data base is prohibited except for the following purpose: the 14 15 information will be provided to the Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) on a call-by-call basis only for the purpose of handling 16 17 emergency calls or for training, and any permanent record of the information shall be secured by the Public Safety Answering Point 18 19 (PSAP) and disposed of in a manner which will retain that 20 security, except upon court order or subpoena from a court of competent jurisdiction or as otherwise provided by law. 21 * * * 2.2 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 23
