- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 73-3-125, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 73-3-125. All lawyers over the age of seventy-five (75)
- 8 years, and the judges of the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals and
- 9 circuit, chancery and county judges, United States magistrates,
- 10 judges of the bankruptcy courts, and the judges of the federal
- 11 courts are exempt from the payment of enrollment fees. <u>Lawyers</u>
- 12 <u>over the age of seventy-five (75) years and judges</u> of the classes
- 13 enumerated in this section shall be active members except that no
- 14 judge shall be eligible to membership on the Board of
- 15 Commissioners. Lawyers who have retired from the practice of law
- 16 because of age, serious illness or permanent disability may be
- 17 placed on inactive status and shall be exempt from the payment of
- 18 <u>enrollment fees.</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 20 and after July 1, 2000.
