- 6 SECTION 1. Section 63-7-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 7
- 63-7-11. Every vehicle operated upon a highway within this 8
- state during the period from sunset to sunrise, and at any other 9
- 10 time when precipitation necessitates the use of windshield wipers
- by vehicle operators or there is not sufficient light to render 11
- clearly discernible any person on the highway at a distance of 12
- 13 five hundred (500) feet ahead, shall be equipped with lighted
- front and rear lamps as respectively required in Section 63-7-13 14
- 15 for different classes of vehicles and subject to exemption with
- reference to lights on parked vehicles as hereinafter stated in 16
- 17 this chapter.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 18
- and after July 1, 2000. 19
