- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. The school board of a local school district, in
- its discretion, may authorize the schools in that district to 6
- 7 include in their curriculum an academic Bible course designed to
- teach students about the Bible. The instruction in any Bible 8
- 9 course offered in the public schools must be objective,
- 10 nonjudgmental, academic, neutral, balanced and fair and may not be
- sectarian, proselytizing or advocating the practice of religion or 11
- any particular religious belief. School districts authorizing a 12
- 13 Bible course shall take such steps as may be necessary to ensure
- 14 that teachers of the Bible course understand the distinction
- between advocacy, proselytizing and the practice of religion and 15
- 16 teaching about the Bible in an objective, nonjudgmental, academic,
- neutral, balanced and fair manner. The participation of students 17
- in any academic Bible course offered in the public schools must be 18
- 19 voluntary.
- 20 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after July 1, 2000.
