HOUSE BILL NO. 1090

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE SALARY OF THE COUNTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY IN CERTAIN 2 COUNTIES AND TO REQUIRE THE PAYMENT OF A MONTHLY EXPENSE ALLOWANCE 3 TO SUCH COUNTY ATTORNEYS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 25-3-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows: 25-3-9. (1) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3) 8 of this section, the county prosecuting attorney may receive for 9 10 his services an annual salary to be paid by the board of supervisors as follows: 11 12 (a) For counties with a total population of more than 13 two hundred thousand (200,000), a salary not to exceed Twenty-eight Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$28,500.00). 14 15 (b) For counties with a total population of more than one hundred thousand (100,000) and not more than two hundred 16 17 thousand (200,000), a salary not to exceed Twenty-six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$26,500.00). 18 (c) For counties with a total population of more than 19 20 fifty thousand (50,000) and not more than one hundred thousand (100,000), a salary not to exceed Twenty-one Thousand Seven 21 Hundred Dollars (\$21,700.00). 22 (d) For counties with a total population of more than 23 thirty-five thousand (35,000) and not more than fifty thousand 24 25 (50,000), a salary not to exceed Twenty Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$20,400.00). 26 27 (e) For counties with a total population of more than

twenty-five thousand (25,000) and not more than thirty-five thousand (35,000), a salary not to exceed Nineteen Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$19,300.00).

31 (f) For counties with a total population of more than 32 fifteen thousand (15,000) and not more than twenty-five thousand 33 (25,000), a salary not to exceed Seventeen Thousand Seven Hundred 34 Dollars (\$17,700.00).

35 (g) For counties with a total population of more than 36 ten thousand (10,000) and not more than fifteen thousand (15,000), 37 a salary not to exceed Sixteen Thousand One Hundred Dollars 38 (\$16,100.00).

39 (h) For counties with a total population of more than 40 six thousand (6,000) and not more than ten thousand (10,000), a 41 salary not to exceed Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars 42 (\$14,500.00).

43 (i) For counties with a total population of six
44 thousand (6,000) or less, the board of supervisors, in its
45 discretion, may appoint a county prosecuting attorney, and it may
46 pay such county prosecuting attorney an annual salary not to
47 exceed Twelve Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$12,900.00).

In all cases of conviction there shall be taxed against the convicted defendant, as an item of cost, the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00), which shall be turned in to the county treasury as a part of the general county funds; however, the Three Dollars (\$3.00) shall not be taxed in any case in which it is not the specific duty of the county attorney to appear and prosecute.

54 From and after October 1, 1993, in addition to the salaries 55 provided for in this subsection, the board of supervisors of any 56 county, in its discretion, may pay the county prosecuting attorney 57 an additional amount not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the 58 maximum allowable salary prescribed herein.

59 (2) In the following counties, the county prosecuting60 attorney shall receive for his services an annual salary to be

61 paid by the board of supervisors, as follows:

In any county bordering upon the Mississippi River 62 (a) 63 and having a population of not less than thirty thousand (30,000) and not more than thirty-five thousand five hundred (35,500) 64 65 according to the federal census of 1990, and in counties having a population of not more than thirty-seven thousand (37,000) 66 according to the federal census of 1990 in which Interstate 67 Highway 55 and U.S. Highway 98 intersect, the county prosecuting 68 69 attorney shall receive a salary equal to the justice court judge 70 of such county; and in any county wherein is located the state's oldest state-supported institution of higher learning and wherein 71 72 Mississippi State Highways 7 and 6 intersect, the county 73 prosecuting attorney shall receive an annual salary equal to that 74 of a member of the board of supervisors of such county.

75 In counties having a population in excess of fifty (b) 76 thousand (50,000) in the 1960 federal census, wherein is located a 77 state-supported university and in which U.S. Highways 49 and 11 intersect, the salary of the county prosecuting attorney shall be 78 79 not less than Seventeen Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$17,400.00) The Board of Supervisors of Forrest County, 80 per year. 81 Mississippi, may, in its discretion, and by agreement with the county prosecuting attorney, employ the county prosecuting 82 83 attorney as a full-time elected official during his/her term of 84 office, designate additional duties and responsibilities of the office and pay additional compensation up to, but not in excess 85 86 of, ninety percent (90%) of the annual compensation and salary of 87 the county court judge and the youth court judge of Forrest County as authorized by law and provide a reasonable office and 88 reasonable office expenses to the county prosecuting attorney. 89 90 The salary authorized by this paragraph (b) for the county 91 prosecuting attorney shall be the sole and complete salary for such prosecuting attorney in each county to which this paragraph 92 93 applies, notwithstanding any other provision of law to the

94 contrary.

95 (c) In any county wherein is housed the seat of State 96 Government, wherein U.S. Highways 80 and 49 intersect, and having 97 two (2) judicial districts, the board of supervisors, in its 98 discretion, may pay the county prosecuting attorney an annual 99 salary equal to the annual salary of members of the board of 100 supervisors in the county.

101 In any county which has two (2) judicial districts (d) and wherein Highway 8 and Highway 15 intersect, having a 102 103 population of greater than seventeen thousand (17,000), according 104 to the 1980 federal decennial census, the board of supervisors 105 shall pay the county prosecuting attorney a salary equal to that 106 of a member of the board of supervisors of such county; provided 107 that if such county prosecuting attorney is paid a sum for the 108 purpose of defraying office or secretarial expenses, then the 109 salary prescribed herein shall be reduced by that amount.

(e) In any county bordering the State of Tennessee and in which Mississippi Highways No. 4 and 15 intersect, and having a population of less than twenty thousand (20,000) in the 1970 federal census, the salary of the county prosecuting attorney shall be no less than Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00).

(f) In any county having a population of more than twenty-five thousand (25,000) and in which U.S. Highways 72 and 45 intersect, the salary of the county attorney shall be paid not less than Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00).

119 In addition, such county prosecuting attorney shall receive 120 the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) per month 121 for the purpose of defraying secretarial expense.

(g) In any county wherein I-20 and State Highway 15 intersect; and in any county wherein I-20 and State Highway 35 intersect, the salary of the county prosecuting attorney shall be not less than Eight Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$8,400.00).

126 (h) In any Class 1 county bordering on the Mississippi

127 River, lying in whole or in part within a levee district, wherein U.S. Highways 82 and 61 intersect, bounded by the Sunflower River 128 129 and Stales Bayou, the board of supervisors, in its discretion, may pay an annual salary equal to the annual salary of members of the 130 131 board of supervisors in the county. In addition, such county prosecuting attorney shall receive the sum of One Thousand Dollars 132 (\$1,000.00) per month for the purpose of defraying secretarial 133 134 expenses.

135 (i) In any county bordering on the Gulf of Mexico 136 having two (2) judicial districts, and wherein U.S. Highways 90 and 49 intersect, the salary of the county prosecuting attorney 137 138 shall be not less than Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000.00) per year. The Board of Supervisors of Harrison County, Mississippi, 139 may, in its discretion, and by agreement with the county 140 prosecuting attorney, employ the county prosecuting attorney and 141 142 his/her assistant during his/her term of office, and designate 143 additional duties and responsibilities of the office and pay additional compensation up to, but not in excess of, ninety 144 145 percent (90%) of the annual compensation and salary of the county 146 court judges of Harrison County as authorized by law and provide 147 adequate office space and reasonable office expenses to the county prosecuting attorney and his/her assistant. The salary authorized 148 149 by this paragraph (i) for the county prosecuting attorney and 150 his/her assistant shall be the sole and complete salary paid by the county for such prosecuting attorney and his/her assistant in 151 152 each county to which this paragraph applies, notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary. 153

(j) In any county bordering on the State of Alabama,
having a population in excess of seventy-five thousand (75,000)
according to the 1980 decennial census in which is located an
institution of higher learning and a United States military
installation and which is traversed by an interstate highway, the
salary of the county prosecuting attorney shall not be less than

160 Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) nor more than the amount of 161 the annual salary received by a member of the board of supervisors 162 of that county.

163 (k) In any county with a land area wherein Mississippi 164 Highways 8 and 9 intersect, the salary of the county prosecuting 165 attorney shall be not less than Eight Thousand Five Hundred 166 Dollars (\$8,500.00) per year.

(1) In any Class 2 county wherein Mississippi Highways and 3 intersect, the salary of the county prosecuting attorney shall be not less than Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) per year nor more than the amount of the annual salary received by a member of the board of supervisors of that county.

(m) In any county wherein Interstate Highway 55 and State Highway 8 intersect, the salary of the county prosecuting attorney shall be not less than Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) per year.

(n) In any county wherein U.S. Highway 51 intersects
Mississippi Highway 6, and having two (2) judicial districts, the
salary of the county prosecuting attorney shall be not less than
Three Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$3,600.00) per year.

180 (0) In any county bordering on the Alabama state line, having a population of greater than fifteen thousand (15,000) 181 according to the 1970 federal decennial census, wherein U.S. 182 183 Highway 45 and Mississippi Highway 18 intersect, the salary of the county prosecuting attorney shall be not less than Three Thousand 184 185 Six Hundred Dollars (\$3,600.00) nor greater than that of a member of the board of supervisors of such county. All prior acts, 186 187 orders and resolutions of the board of supervisors of such county 188 which authorized the payment of the salary in conformity with the provisions of this paragraph, whether or not heretofore 189 190 specifically authorized by law are hereby ratified, approved and confirmed. 191

(p) In any county wherein is located a state-supported

193 institution of higher learning and wherein U.S. Highway 82 and 194 Mississippi Highway 389 intersect, the board of supervisors, in 195 its discretion, may pay the county prosecuting attorney an annual 196 salary equal to the annual salary of members of the board of 197 supervisors in the county.

(q) In any county having two (2) judicial districts wherein Mississippi Highway 32 intersects U.S. Highway 49E, the salary of the county prosecuting attorney shall be not less than Twelve Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$12,700.00).

(r) In any county traversed by the Natchez Trace
Parkway wherein U.S. Highway 45 and Mississippi Highway 4
intersect, the board of supervisors, in its discretion, may pay
the county prosecuting attorney an annual salary equal to the
annual salary of justice court judges in the county.

207 In any county having a population of more than (s) 208 fourteen thousand (14,000) according to the 1970 census and which 209 county is bordered on the north by the State of Tennessee and on 210 the east by the State of Alabama and in which U.S. Highway No. 72 211 and Highway No. 25 intersect, the board of supervisors, in its 212 discretion, may pay the county prosecuting attorney an annual 213 salary equal to the annual salary of justice court judges in the 214 county.

215 (t) (i) In any county wherein Interstate Highway 55 216 and State Highway 22 intersect, and which is also traversed in 217 whole or part by U.S. Highways 49 and 51, and State Highways 16, 218 17, 43 and the Natchez Trace Parkway, and also containing a part of a public lake or reservoir, in excess of thirty thousand 219 (30,000) acres, the board of supervisors, in its discretion, may 220 221 pay the county prosecuting attorney an annual salary in the amount of Twenty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$28,000.00). 222

(ii) From and after October 1, 1993, in addition
to the salary provided for item (i) of this paragraph, the board
of supervisors, in its discretion, may pay the county prosecuting

226 attorney an additional amount not to exceed ten percent (10%) of 227 the maximum allowable salary prescribed herein.

(u) In any county having a population in the 1970 census in excess of thirty-five thousand (35,000) and in which U.S. Highways 49W and 82 intersect, and in which is located a state penitentiary, the annual salary of a county prosecuting attorney shall be Thirty Thousand Four Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$30,420.00).

234 (v) In any county wherein Mississippi Highway 50 235 intersects U.S. Highway 45-Alternate, and having a population greater than twenty thousand (20,000) according to the 1980 236 237 federal decennial census, a salary equal to that of a member of the board of supervisors of such county; provided that if such 238 239 county prosecuting attorney is paid a sum for the purpose of 240 defraying office or secretarial expenses, then the salary 241 prescribed herein shall be reduced by that amount.

(w) In any county in which the 1975 assessed valuation
was Forty Million Seven Hundred Thirty-nine Thousand Four Hundred
Sixty-six Dollars (\$40,739,466.00) and wherein U.S. Highway 45 and
Mississippi Highway 8 intersect, the salary of the county
prosecuting attorney shall be equal to that of a member of the
board of supervisors of such county.

248 (x) In any county bordering on the Mississippi River 249 having a population greater than fifty thousand (50,000) according 250 to the 1980 federal decennial census and also having a national 251 military park and national cemetery, an annual salary of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) or a salary equal to 252 253 that of a member of the board of supervisors in such county, 254 whichever is greater. In addition, such county prosecuting 255 attorney shall receive the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) 256 per month for the purpose of defraying secretarial expenses.

(y) In any county bordering on the Alabama state line,
traversed by the Chickasawhay River, and wherein U.S. Highway 45

259 and U.S. Highway 84 intersect, a salary that shall be equal to the annual salary of a member of the board of supervisors of such 260 261 county. All prior acts, orders and resolutions of the board of supervisors of such county which authorize the payment of the 262 263 salary of the county prosecuting attorney in conformity with the provisions of this section as it existed immediately prior to the 264 effective date of Chapter 506, Laws of 1985, are hereby ratified, 265 266 approved, confirmed and validated.

(z) In any county having a population greater than
sixty-five thousand five hundred eighty (65,580) but less than
sixty-five thousand five hundred ninety (65,590) according to the
1990 federal decennial census, wherein U.S. Highway 45 intersects
with Mississippi Highway 6, an annual salary equal to Thirty
Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00).

273 In any county where an institution of higher (aa) 274 learning is located and wherein U.S. Highway 82 and U.S. Highway 275 45 intersect, the salary of county prosecuting attorney shall be not less than that of a member of the board of supervisors in such 276 277 county, and the board of supervisors may, in its discretion, pay 278 such county prosecuting attorney a salary in an amount not to 279 exceed the amount of the salary of the District Attorney for the 280 Sixteenth Judicial District of Mississippi.

281 (bb) In any county having a population greater than six 282 thousand (6,000) according to the federal decennial census and wherein U.S. Highway 61 and Mississippi Highway 24 intersect, the 283 284 board of supervisors shall pay the county prosecuting attorney an 285 annual salary equal to the annual salary of members of the board 286 of supervisors in the county. In addition, such county 287 prosecuting attorney shall receive the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per month for the purpose of defraying office or 288 289 secretarial expenses.

290 (cc) In any county having a population greater than 291 thirty-one thousand (31,000) according to the 1990 federal

decennial census and wherein U.S. Highway 61 and U.S. Highway 49 intersect, a salary of not less than the annual salary of justice court judges in the county.

295 In any county having a population greater than (dd) 296 eighty-seven thousand (87,000) but less than eighty-seven thousand 297 two hundred (87,200) according to the 1990 federal census, in 298 which is located an international airport, an annual salary of 299 Twenty-nine Thousand Dollars (\$29,000.00). In addition, such 300 county prosecuting attorney shall receive the sum of One Thousand 301 Dollars (\$1,000.00) per month for the purpose of defraying 302 secretarial expenses.

303 In any county having a population greater than (ee)eight thousand (8,000) but less than eight thousand two hundred 304 305 (8,200) according to the 1990 federal census, and in which U.S. 306 Highway 61 and Mississippi Highway 4 intersect, the board of 307 supervisors may, in its discretion, pay the county prosecuting 308 attorney an amount not to exceed Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000.00), in addition to the maximum allowable salary for that 309 310 attorney under subsection (1), beginning on April 1, 1997.

(ff) In any county having a population greater than thirty thousand three hundred (30,300) but less than thirty thousand four hundred (30,400) according to the 1990 federal census, and in which U.S. Highway 78 and Mississippi Highway 7 intersect, a salary of not less than the annual salary of a member of the board of supervisors in such county.

317 (gg) In any county having a population greater than thirteen thousand three hundred (13,300) but less than thirteen 318 319 thousand four hundred (13,400) according to the 1990 federal 320 census, and in which Mississippi Highway 24 and Mississippi Highway 48 intersect, the board of supervisors may, in its 321 322 discretion, pay the county prosecuting attorney an additional amount not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the maximum allowable 323 324 salary for that attorney under subsection (1).

325 (hh) In any county having a population greater than eight thousand three hundred (8,300) but less than eight thousand 326 327 four hundred (8,400) according to the 1990 federal census, and in which U.S. Highway 84 and U.S. Highway 98 intersect, the board of 328 329 supervisors may, in its discretion, pay the county prosecuting attorney an additional amount not to exceed ten percent (10%) of 330 331 the maximum allowable salary for that attorney under subsection 332 (1).

(ii) After September 30, 1993, in any county having a 333 334 population of more than thirty thousand four hundred (30,400) and which is traversed in whole or part by I-59, U.S. Highways 98 and 335 336 11 and State Highway 13, the annual salary of the county prosecuting attorney shall be Twenty-five Thousand Dollars 337 (\$25,000.00). In addition, such county prosecuting attorney shall 338 receive after September 30, 1993, the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty 339 340 Dollars (\$750.00) per month for the purpose of defraying office or 341 secretarial expenses.

342 (jj) In any county having a population greater than 343 twenty thousand (20,000) according to the 1990 federal census and 344 wherein U.S. Highway 78 and Mississippi Highway 25 intersect, the 345 board of supervisors, in its discretion, may pay the county 346 prosecuting attorney an annual salary equal to the annual salary 347 of justice court judges in the county.

348 In any county having a population greater than (kk) twelve thousand four hundred (12,400) but less than twelve 349 thousand five hundred (12,500) according to the 1990 federal 350 census, and in which U.S. Highway 84 and Mississippi Highway 27 351 352 intersect, the board of supervisors may, in its discretion, pay 353 the county prosecuting attorney an additional amount not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the maximum allowable salary for that 354 355 attorney under subsection (1).

356 (11) In any county having a population greater than357 thirty thousand two hundred (30,200) but less than thirty thousand

three hundred (30,300) according to the 1990 federal census, and in which U.S. Interstate 55 and Mississippi Highway 84 intersect, the board of supervisors may, in its discretion, pay the county prosecuting attorney an additional amount not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the maximum allowable salary for that attorney under subsection (1).

364 In any county on the Mississippi River levee, ( mm ) 365 having a population greater than forty-one thousand eight hundred 366 (41,800) but less than forty-one thousand nine hundred (41,900) 367 according to the 1990 federal census wherein U.S. Highway 61 and Mississippi Highway 8 intersect, the board of supervisors, in its 368 369 discretion, may pay the county prosecuting attorney an annual salary equal to the annual salary of members of the board of 370 371 supervisors in the county. In addition, the board of supervisors, 372 in its discretion, may pay the county prosecuting attorney the sum 373 of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per month for the purpose of 374 defraying secretarial expenses.

(nn) In any county having a population greater than twenty-four thousand seven hundred (24,700) and less than twenty-four thousand nine hundred (24,900) according to the 1990 federal census, wherein Mississippi Highways 15 and 16 intersect, the board of supervisors, in its discretion, may pay the county prosecuting attorney an annual salary equal to the annual salary of members of the board of supervisors in the county.

In any county having a population greater than 382 (00) 383 thirty-seven thousand (37,000) but less than thirty-eight thousand (38,000) according to the 1990 federal census, in which is located 384 a state supported institution of higher learning, and in which 385 386 U.S. Highway 82 and Mississippi Highway 7 intersect, the board of supervisors may, in its discretion, pay the county prosecuting 387 388 attorney a salary in an amount not to exceed the amount of the 389 salary of the District Attorney for the Fourth Judicial District 390 of Mississippi.

(pp) In any county in which U.S. Highway 78 and Mississippi Highway 15 intersect and which is traversed by the Tallahatchie River, a salary equal to that of members of the board of supervisors of the county, which salary shall be in addition to any sums received for the purpose of defraying office or secretarial expenses and sums received as youth court prosecutor fees.

398 (qq) In any county bordering on the State of Tennessee 399 and the State of Arkansas, wherein Interstate Highway 55 and 400 Mississippi Highway 302 intersect, the board of supervisors, in 401 its discretion, may pay the county prosecuting attorney an annual 402 salary equal to the annual salary of justice court judges in the 403 county.

404 (rr) In any county that is traversed by the Natchez 405 Trace Parkway and in which Mississippi Highway 35 and Mississippi 406 Highway 12 intersect, the board of supervisors, in its discretion, 407 may pay the county prosecuting attorney an annual salary in the 408 amount of the annual salary of justice court judges in the county.

409 (ss) In any county in which Mississippi Highway 14 and 410 Mississippi Highway 25 intersect, the board of supervisors, in its 411 discretion, may pay the county prosecuting attorney an annual 412 salary in the amount of Twenty-two Thousand Dollars (\$22,000.00).

(tt) In any county in which Interstate Highway 59 and U.S. Highway 84 intersect, the board of supervisors, in its discretion, may pay the county prosecuting attorney an annual salary equal to the annual salary of members of the board of supervisors in the county.

(3) In any case where a salary, expense allowance or other sum is authorized or paid by the board of supervisors pursuant to this section, that salary, expense allowance or other sum shall not be reduced or terminated during the term for which the county attorney was elected.

3 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi

424 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor, 425 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the 426 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States 427 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the 428 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and 429 extended.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 430 and after October 1, 2000, if it is effectuated on or before that 431 date under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended 432 433 and extended. If it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting 434 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended, after October 1, 435 2000, this act shall take effect and be in force from and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting Rights 436 Act of 1965, as amended and extended. 437
