AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 2, CHAPTER 464, LAWS OF 1999, TO REVISE THE MANNER IN WHICH THE PROCEEDS OF THE GENERAL OBLIGATION 1 2 3 BONDS AUTHORIZED TO BE ISSUED BY THIS ACT MAY BE UTILIZED BY THE 4 DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS; AND FOR RELATED 5 PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 SECTION 1. Section 2, Chapter 464, Laws of 1999, is amended 8 as follows: Section 2. (1) (a) A special fund, to be designated as the 9 "1999 Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks Improvements 10 11 Fund" is created within the State Treasury. The fund shall be maintained by the State Treasurer as a separate and special fund, 12 13 separate and apart from the General Fund of the state and 14 investment earnings on amounts in the fund shall be deposited into 15 such fund. Promptly after the commission has certified, by

resolution duly adopted, that the projects described in subsection

(1) shall have been completed, abandoned, or cannot be completed

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127 in a timely fashion, any amounts remaining in such special fund shall be applied to pay debt service on the bonds issued under 128 129 this act, in accordance with the proceedings authorizing the 130 issuance of such bonds and as directed by the commission. 131 (3) The Department of Finance and Administration, acting 132 through the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property 133 Management, is expressly authorized and empowered to receive and 134 expend any local or other source funds in connection with the 135 expenditure of funds provided for in this section. The 136 expenditure of monies deposited into the special fund shall be 137 under the direction of the Department of Finance and 138 Administration, and such funds shall be paid by the State Treasurer upon warrants issued by such department, which warrants 139 140 shall be issued upon requisitions signed by the Executive Director
