- 3 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN SECTION OF HIGHWAY IN WEBSTER 4AND CHOCTAW COUNTIES AS A PART OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM AND TO 5 PLACE IT UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION 6 COMMISSION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The mileage of highway specifically

9designated in subsection (2) of this subsection is in addition to

10 the total mileage limitation of eight thousand six hundred (8,600)

11 miles that is set out in Section 65-3-3.

- 12 (2) The following highway is designated as a state highway
- 13 and is placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi

14Transportation Commission for construction and maintenance; and 15 such highway, together with the highways designated in Sections 1665-3-3 and 65-3-5, and all other laws adding links to the 17designated state highway system, are declared to be the state 18 highway system of Mississippi.

- Northern District Webster and Choctaw Counties:
- 20 A highway segment beginning at the intersection of
- 21 Mississippi Highway 9 and the Natchez Trace Parkway and
- 22 extending in a northwesterly direction to U.S. Highway 82
- 23 at or near Tomnolen.
- 24 (3) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall
 25 maintain, construct, take over and assume jurisdiction of the
 26 highway designated in subsection (2) of this section in the same
 27 manner and upon the same terms and conditions as set out in
 28 Sections 65-1-75, 65-3-3, 65-9-1 and 65-9-3.
- 29 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

30 and after July 1, 2000.
