HOUSE BILL NO. 1206

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO DUALLY ENROLL HOME SCHOOL STUDENTS UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "home school
- 6 students" are those children taught by private teachers, parents,
- 7 guardians or custodians in a legitimate home instruction program
- 8 as defined in the Mississippi Compulsory School Attendance Law
- 9 (Section 37-13-91).
- 10 (2) Upon the request of a parent, guardian or legal
- 11 custodian of a home school student, the local school board may
- 12 register the student in a public school for dual enrollment
- 13 purposes, as provided under this section. If the home school
- 14 student is enrolled in a public school district for dual
- 15 enrollment purposes, the home school student may participate in
- 16 any academic activities in the district on a part-time basis and
- 17 also may participate on the same basis as public school students
- 18 in any extracurricular activities available to students in the
- 19 home school student's grade. A home school student applying for
- 20 dual enrollment must reside within the attendance boundaries of
- 21 the school in which the student is seeking enrollment. Request
- 22 for dual enrollment in the following school year must be submitted
- 23 by the parent, guardian or legal custodian before May 1.
- 24 (3) Any home school student dually enrolled in a public
- 25 school shall be included in the school's attendance for purposes
- 26 of minimum education program or adequate education program

- 27 funding.
- 28 (4) Nothing in this section may be construed to require any
- 29 home school student to enroll with any school district for dual
- 30 enrollment purposes.
- 31 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 32 and after its passage.
