HOUSE BILL NO. 1251

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 37-29-63, 37-29-407, 37-29-455, 37-29-509 AND 37-29-555, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 972, TO CLARIFY THE 1 2 3 AUTHORITY OF BOARDS OF TRUSTEES OF COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICTS TO ACCEPT OR REJECT THE DISTRICT PRESIDENT'S 4 RECOMMENDATION ON THE EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONNEL EMPLOYED UNDER 5 CONTRACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 37-29-63, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 9 amended as follows:[HS1] 37-29-63. The president of any <u>community or</u> junior college 10 11 shall have the power to recommend to the board of trustees all teachers, instructors, professors and other employees to be 12 employed <u>under contract with</u> the district. <u>The board of trustees</u>, 13 14 in its discretion, may accept or decline to accept the recommendation of the president to employ or not to employ a 15 teacher, instructor, professor or other employee under contract 16 17 with the district, and such decision of the board of trustees shall be final. The president may remove or suspend any member of 18 the faculty, subject to the approval of the trustees. He shall be 19 the general manager of all fiscal and administrative affairs of 20 21 the district with full authority to select, direct, employ and discharge any and all employees other than teachers, instructors, 22 professors and other employees under contract with the district; 23 however, the board may make provisions and establish policies for 2.4 25 leave for faculty members and other key personnel. 26 The president shall have the authority, subject to the provisions of Sections 37-29-1 through 37-29-273 and the approval 27 of the trustees, to arrange and survey courses of study, fix 2.8

32 SECTION 2. Section 37-29-407, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 33 amended as follows:[HS2]

34 37-29-407. The president of the community college shall have the power to recommend to the trustees all teachers, instructors, 35 36 professors and other employees to be employed under contract with the district. The board of trustees, in its discretion, may 37 accept or decline to accept the recommendation of the president to 38 employ or not to employ a teacher, instructor, professor or other 39 employee under contract with the district, and such decision of 40 the board shall be final. The president may remove or suspend any 41 member of the faculty, subject to the approval of the trustees. 42 43 He shall be the general manager of all fiscal and administrative affairs of the district with full authority to select, direct, 44 employ and discharge any and all employees other than teachers, 45 instructors, professors and other employees under contract with 46 47 the district.

The president shall have the authority, subject to the provisions of Sections 37-29-401 <u>through</u> 37-29-437 and the approval of the trustees, to arrange and survey courses of study, fix schedules, and establish and enforce rules and discipline for the governing of teachers and students. He shall be the general custodian of the property of the district.

54 SECTION 3. Section 37-29-455, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 55 amended as follows:[HS3]

37-29-455. The president of the community college shall have 56 57 the power to recommend to the trustees all teachers, instructors, 58 professors and other employees to be employed under contract with the district. The board of trustees, in its discretion, may 59 60 accept or decline to accept the recommendation of the president to 61 employ or not to employ a teacher, instructor, professor or other employee under contract with the district, and such decision of 62 the board shall be final. The president may remove or suspend any 63 64 member of the faculty, subject to the approval of the trustees. He shall be the general manager of all fiscal and administrative 65

affairs of the district with full authority to select, direct, 66 67 employ and discharge any and all employees other than teachers, instructors, professors and other employees under contract with 68 69 the district; however, the board may make provisions and establish 70 policies for leave for faculty members and other key personnel. The president shall have the authority, subject to the 71 provisions of Sections 37-29-451 through 37-29-471 and the 72 approval of the trustees, to arrange and survey courses of study, 73 74 fix schedules, and establish and enforce rules and discipline for 75 the governing of teachers and students. He shall be the general 76 custodian of the property of the district.

77 SECTION 4. Section 37-29-509, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 78 amended as follows:[HS4]

79 37-29-509. (1) The Meridian Junior College District shall 80 be under the executive direction of a president elected by the 81 board of trustees of such district.

82 The president of the community college shall be general (2) manager of all fiscal and administrative affairs of the district 83 84 with full authority to select, employ, direct and discharge any 85 and all employees other than faculty. He shall have the power to 86 recommend to the board of trustees all faculty to be employed, under contract with the district. The board of trustees, in its 87 88 discretion, may accept or decline to accept the recommendation of the president to employ or not to employ a person under contract 89 with the district, and such decision of the board shall be final. 90 91 The president may remove or suspend any member of the faculty, subject to the approval of the board of trustees. The president 92 shall have the authority, subject to the approval of the board of 93 trustees, to arrange and survey courses of study, fix schedules 94 95 and establish and enforce rules and discipline for the governing 96 of faculty and students. He shall be the general custodian of the 97 property of the district. For purposes of this subsection, the 98 term "faculty" includes, but is not necessarily limited to,

101 SECTION 5. Section 37-29-555, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 102 amended as follows:[HS5]

103 37-29-555. The president of the community college shall have the power to recommend to the trustees all teachers, instructors, 104 professors and other employees to be employed under contract with 105 the district. The board of trustees, in its discretion, may 106 accept or decline to accept the recommendation of the president to 107 108 employ or not to employ a teacher, instructor, professor or other employee under contract with the district, and such decision of 109 the board shall be final. The president may remove or suspend any 110 111 member of the faculty, subject to the approval of the trustees. He shall be the general manager of all fiscal and administrative 112 affairs of the district with full authority to select, direct, 113 114 employ and discharge any and all employees other than teachers, 115 instructors, professors and other employees under contract with the district; however, the board may make provisions and establish 116 117 policies for leave for faculty members and other key personnel. The president shall have the authority, subject to the 118 119 provisions of Sections 37-29-551 through 37-29-569 and the approval of the trustees, to arrange and survey courses of study, 120 fix schedules, and establish and enforce rules and discipline for 121 122 the governing of teachers and students. He shall be the general custodian of the property of the district. 123

124 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 125 and after July 1, 2000.
