## HOUSE BILL NO. 1259

AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW CODE SECTION TO BE CODIFIED AS SECTION 27-19-56.15, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS TO MEMBERS OF CIVITAN INTERNATIONAL; 1 2 3 4 TO PROVIDE AN ADDITIONAL FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH DISTINCTIVE 5 LICENSE TAGS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. б BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 8 27-19-56.15, Mississippi Code of 1972: 27-19-56.15. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 9 10 resident of this state and who is a member of Civitan International, upon payment of the road and bridge privilege 11 taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law 12 13 for private carriers of passengers, pickup trucks and other 14 noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this section, 15 shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each motor vehicle 16 registered in his name identifying such person as a member of 17 Civitan International. The distinctive license tags so issued 18 shall be of such color and design as the State Tax Commission, 19 with the advice of Civitan International, may prescribe, and shall 20 21 consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license tag. 22

(2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized
by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms
prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the
additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less
three percent (3%) thereof to be retained by the tax collector,

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days of the date the application is made. The portion of the
additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited
into the county general fund. The portion of the additional fee
remitted to the State Tax Commission shall be deposited into the
State Treasury on the day it is received and shall be deposited by
the State Treasurer into the State General Fund.

35 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or after July 1, 2000, any person applying for a distinctive license 36 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 37 of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for each distinctive license tag 38 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all 39 40 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 41 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 42 time the original application is made for a distinctive license 43 44 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 45 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 46 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive 47 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax collector. 48

(4) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as 49 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 50 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the 51 52 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license 53 54 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, which will expire the same month and year as the regular license 55 56 tag.

In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license 57 (5) tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 58 59 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 60 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 61 62 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 63 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be 64

67 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 68 and after July 1, 2000.
