HOUSE BILL NO. 1292

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARDS TO COMPENSATE
2 LICENSED AND NONLICENSED EMPLOYEES FOR EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES
3 WITHOUT MAKING ANY WITHHOLDINGS FOR STATE INCOME TAX PURPOSES OR
4 OTHER DEDUCTIONS FOR RETIREMENT OR OTHER BENEFITS; AND FOR RELATED
5 PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 SECTION 1. The school board of a local school district, in
8 its discretion, may use any available funds of the district other
9 than minimum education or adequate education program funds for
10 compensating licensed and nonlicensed school employees for
11 assisting with extracurricular activities when such activities are
12 outside the scope of the employee's primary job description. The
13 school board shall establish the amount of the additional
14 compensation for such work, which additional compensation may be
15 paid to licensed and nonlicensed employees without any
16 withholdings for state income tax purposes or other deductions for
17 retirement or other benefits.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
19 and after July 1, 2000.
