HOUSE BILL NO. 1304

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-23-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 972, TO 2 CLARIFY THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION MAY EXPEND FUNDS IN 3 MAKING REASONABLE ACCOMMODATIONS FOR TEACHERS WITH VARIOUS 4 DISABILITIES, WITHOUT LIMITING THE DISABILITY TO ONE OF VISUAL 5 IMPAIRMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 37-23-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:

37-23-13. (1) The school board of any school district is 9 10 hereby authorized to comply with the provisions of the Federal 11 Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 USCS Sections 12101-12213 (West Supp. 1991)) by making reasonable accommodations 12 13 to the known physical or mental limitations of an otherwise 14 qualified individual with a disability who is an applicant or employee, unless the school board can demonstrate that the 15 16 accommodation would impose an undue hardship on the operation of the school. The school board of any such school district 17 determining that such accommodation is required and reasonable 18 may, by resolution spread upon its minutes, apply to the State 19 Department of Education for funds to defray the cost of making the 20 21 reasonable accommodations, as determined by the school board to be in the best interest of the individual teacher, for * * * teachers 2.2 23 with disabilities in compliance with said federal law. The State Department of Education, within the 24 (2)

25 availability of funds appropriated for such purpose, may expend 26 funds for the purpose of defraying the expenses of school 27 districts in <u>making the reasonable accommodations</u>, as determined

The department shall, by regulation, prescribe a method and necessary forms for the purpose of school districts' applications for funds as authorized herein. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

35 and after July 1, 2000.
