HOUSE BILL NO. 1316

AN ACT TO CREATE A JOINT COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT A STUDY ON THE 1 2 BAITING OF WHITE-TAILED DEER, THE DECLINE IN THE NUMBER OF SALES OF DEER HUNTING LICENSES, THE EXTENSION OF DEER SEASON AND BAG 3 LIMITS, AND TO REQUIRE THE COMMITTEE TO ASSESS CONSTRUCTION AND 4 5 UPDATES CONCERNING FISH HATCHERIES; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS TO COORDINATE THE STUDY; TO PROVIDE THAT A REPORT SUMMARIZING THE RESULTS OF THE STUDY AND б 7 8 RECOMMENDATIONS SHALL BE FILED WITH THE LEGISLATURE BY DECEMBER 31, 2000; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 9

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) There is created a white-tailed deer and fish hatcheries study committee. The committee shall consist of 12 the following members: (a) the Chairman of the Senate Wildlife, 13 Fisheries and Parks Committee; (b) the Chairman of the House Game 14 15 and Fish Committee; (c) two (2) members of the Commission on 16 Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks appointed by the chairman of the commission; (d) a wildlife biologist to be recommended by the 17 Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Wildlife, 18 Fisheries and Parks and appointed by the Lieutenant Governor; (e) 19 a wildlife biologist to be recommended by the Executive Director 20 of the Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks and 21 appointed by the Speaker of the House; (f) three (3) members of 22 23 the Senate Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks Committee appointed by the Lieutenant Governor; and (g) three (3) members of the House 2.4 25 Game and Fish Committee appointed by the Speaker of the House. The Chairman of the Senate Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks 26 Committee and the Chairman of the House Game and Fish Committee 27 shall serve as cochair of the study committee. 28

29 For attending meetings of the committee, each legislative

No. 1316 00\HR03\R1617 PAGE 1 30 member shall be paid per diem in the amount authorized by Section 31 25-3-69 and a mileage allowance and an expense allowance in the amount authorized by Section 5-1-47 from the contingent expense 32 33 fund of his respective house. However, no per diem, mileage 34 allowance or expense allowance shall be paid for attending 35 meetings of the committee while the Legislature is in session, and 36 no per diem, mileage allowance or expense allowance shall be paid 37 without prior approval of the proper committee in the member's 38 respective house.

39 (2) In conducting its activities, the committee may elicit 40 the support of and participation by any commercial, industrial, 41 governmental, environmental, minority and public interest 42 organizations and associations, or individual members thereof, and 43 any federal, state and local agencies and political subdivisions 44 as may be necessary or appropriate in the furtherance of the 45 study.

The Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks or the 46 (3) 47 department's designee shall coordinate the study of the advantages and disadvantages of baiting white-tailed deer; the decline in the 48 49 number of sales of deer hunting licenses and a plan of action 50 which may be implemented by the Legislature to combat the decline; and the extension of deer season and bag limits, including doe 51 52 season. The study shall further assess construction and updates 53 concerning fish hatcheries.

54 (4) The committee shall prepare a report of the study with
55 recommendations and file the report with the Legislature by
56 December 31, 2000. Upon presentation of its report to the
57 Legislature, the committee shall be dissolved.

(5) Nothing in this act shall restrict the discussion and
consideration by the committee of any other wildlife laws, rules,
and regulations in addition to the matters described in subsection
(3) of this section.
