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1 2 3	AN ACT TO DEFINE THE COMPREHENSIVE COUNSELING SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS BY SCHOOL GUIDANCE COUNSELORS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. (1) Beginning with the 2000-2001 school year,
6	the assignment of school guidance counselors in Grades K-12 to the
7	particular schools within a school district shall be at the
8	discretion of the local school board with the following
9	restrictions:
10	(a) No individual may be employed as a school guidance
11	counselor without appropriate training and certification, as
12	determined by the State Department of Education; and
13	(b) School guidance counselors shall be full-time
14	professional personnel and shall spend a minimum of eighty-five
15	percent (85%) of work time in direct counseling relationships with
16	students.
17	(2) School guidance counselors shall provide the following
18	comprehensive counseling services:
19	(a) Academic and personal or social counseling;
20	(b) Student assessment and assessment counseling;
21	(c) Career and educational counseling;
22	(d) Individual and group counseling (large or small
23	groups);
24	(e) Crisis intervention and preventive counseling;
25	(f) Referrals to community agencies;
26	(g) Educational consultation and collaboration with

- 27 teachers, administrators, parents and community leaders;
- 28 (h) Educational and career placement services; and
- 29 (i) Follow-up counseling services.
- 30 (3) The State Department of Education may adopt rules and
- 31 regulations regarding the activities of the school guidance
- 32 counselors which are not inconsistent with this section.
- 33 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 34 and after July 1, 2000.
