HOUSE BILL NO. 1332 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY TO ACCEPT BY DONATION THE COKER HOUSE AND ACCOMPANYING 1 2 3 LAND LOCATED ON THE CHAMPION HILL BATTLEFIELD; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 Section 1. The Mississippi Department of Archives and 7 History, on behalf of the State of Mississippi, is authorized to accept the donation of all right, title, and interest in certain 8 real property located in Hinds County, Mississippi, from Jackson 9 10 Civil War Round Table, Inc., a nonprofit Mississippi corporation, the property being known as the historic Coker House and 11 accompanying land located on the Champion Hill Battlefield, and 12 being more particularly described as follows: 13 A certain tract of land situated in the Northwest 14 15 Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 1, Township 5 North, Range 4 West, Hinds County, Mississippi, 16 17 containing 5.00 acres and being more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a 3/4" galvanized 18 19 pipe, marking the Southeast corner of Section 1, 2.0 Township 5 North, Range 4 West, Hinds County, 21 Mississippi; run thence North 53° 15' West for 2717.47 feet to a point in a fence, said point hereinafter 22 referred to as the point of beginning: Thence North 79° 23 31' West along said fence for 67.16 feet; Thence North 24 25 71° 13' West along said fence for 259.57 feet; Thence North 78° 39' West along said fence for 30.04 feet; 26

- paved road; Thence North 42° 08' East along the East
- line of said road for 618.46 feet to the South line of
- 30 Mississippi State Highway 467; Thence South 70° 44' East
- 31 along the South line of said highway for 379.06 feet;
- 32 Thence South 42° 09' West for 612.27 feet to the point
- of beginning; together with historic dwelling situated
- thereon, known as "The Coker House."
- 35 The Secretary of State shall approve this conveyance and join in
- 36 this conveyance for all purposes.
- 37 SECTION 2. The Mississippi Department of Archives and
- 38 History is authorized to secure, preserve, restore, develop,
- 39 interpret, operate, and maintain the historic Coker House and
- 40 accompanying land on the Champion Hill Battlefield as an official
- 41 state historic site.
- 42 <u>SECTION 3.</u> The Board of Trustees of the Mississippi
- 43 Department of Archives and History is authorized to enter into
- 44 cooperative agreements with the National Park Service, state and
- 45 local government entities, nonprofit organizations, and any other
- 46 groups, organizations or individuals that may be interested in the
- 47 preservation and development of the Coker House and accompanying
- 48 land and the Champion Hill Battlefield.
- 49 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 50 and after its passage.
