## HOUSE BILL NO. 1348

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-31-104, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY PROVISIONS REGARDING FEE IN LIEU AGREEMENTS; AND FOR

3 RELATED PURPOSES.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 27-31-104, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:[HS1]
- 7 27-31-104. County boards of supervisors and municipal
- 8 authorities are hereby authorized and empowered to grant a fee in
- 9 lieu of taxes, including taxes levied for school purposes, for
- 10 projects totaling over One Hundred Million Dollars
- 11 (\$100,000,000.00). In addition to those new enterprises
- 12 enumerated in Section 27-31-101, Mississippi Code of 1972, the
- 13 term "projects," as used in this section, shall include a private
- 14 company (as such term is defined in Section 57-61-5, Mississippi
- 15 Code of 1972) having a minimum capital investment of One Hundred
- 16 Million Dollars (\$100,000,000.00).
- 17 The fee in lieu shall be negotiated by and given final
- 18 approval by the Department of Economic Development.
- The minimum sum allowable as a fee in lieu shall not be less
- 20 than one-third (1/3) of <u>each annual</u> ad valorem levy, <u>during the</u>
- 21 term of the fee in lieu agreement, including ad valorem taxes for
- 22 school district purposes, and the sum allowed shall be apportioned
- 23 between the county or municipality, as appropriate, and the school
- 24 districts in such amounts as may be determined by the county board
- 25 of supervisors or municipal governing authority, as the case may
- 26 be, however, from the sum allowed the apportionment to school

- 27 districts shall not be less than the school districts' pro rata
- 28 share based upon the proportion that the millage imposed for the
- 29 school districts by the appropriate levying authority bears to the
- 30 millage imposed by such levying authority for all other county or
- 31 municipal purposes. The agreement shall be for a term of not more
- 32 than ten (10) years.
- 33 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 34 and after July 1, 2000.
