HOUSE BILL NO. 1352

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE PUBLIC COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGES 1 2 AND STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING TO DEVELOP STUDENT 3 TRANSPORTATION PLANS IN ORDER TO ENSURE THE HIGHEST STANDARDS OF 4 SAFETY FOR STUDENTS TRAVELING TO OFF-CAMPUS EVENTS; TO REQUIRE THE 5 STATE BOARD FOR COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGES AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING TO REVIEW THE 6 7 PLANS OF THE INSTITUTIONS UNDER THEIR JURISDICTION; TO PROHIBIT 8 INSTITUTIONS FAILING TO SUBMIT A PLAN OR CORRECT A PLAN'S 9 DEFICIENCIES FROM USING STATE-APPROPRIATED FUNDS FOR TRAVELING TO 10 AND FROM OFF-CAMPUS EVENTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 12 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) In order to ensure that the students 13 enrolled in the public community and junior colleges and state institutions of higher learning in Mississippi are afforded the 14 15 highest standards of safety when traveling to and from official school-related activities and events away from campus, the Board 16 of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning and the State 17 Board for Community and Junior Colleges shall require the 18 institutions under their jurisdiction to develop a student 19 20 transportation plan. The student transportation plan must include, at a minimum, the following: 21

(a) A listing of the activities and events away from
campus in which students from the institution generally
participate, the approximate number of persons officially
traveling from the campus to each activity or event and the
vehicle or vehicles generally used to transport students to and
from each activity or event;

(b) A description of the institution's fleet of
vehicles used for transporting students to such activities and
events, include the make, model and seating capacity of such

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32 (c) A listing of persons authorized by the institution
33 to operate such vehicles and the qualifications of such persons;

35 (d) Any other information required by the Board of
36 Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning or the State
37 Board for Community and Junior Colleges to be included in the
38 plan.

39 (2) The Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher 40 Learning and the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges 41 shall adopt rules and regulations establishing minimum 42 requirements for student transportation plans and governing the 43 submission of plans by the separate institutions to the respective 44 board for review.

The Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher 45 (3) Learning and the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges 46 shall review the student transportation plan for each institution 47 under its jurisdiction. Upon completing a review of an 48 institution's plan, the board shall either approve the plan or 49 50 return it, along with a written statement of the board's objections and suggestions for correcting the plan's deficiencies, 51 52 to the institution.

(4) Any institution failing to submit its student transportation plan for review to the respective board or failing to correct a plan that has not been approved may not use any state-appropriated funds for the expenses of traveling to and from any off-campus school-related activity or events.

58 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 59 and after July 1, 2000.

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
