## HOUSE BILL NO. 1382

AN ACT TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN SEGMENTS OF MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 1 2 28 AND U.S. HIGHWAY 61 IN JEFFERSON COUNTY AS STATE HIGHWAYS AND TO PLACE SUCH SEGMENTS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI 3 4 TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR MAINTENANCE; AND FOR RELATED 5 PURPOSES. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. (1) The mileage of highway specifically 8 designated in subsection (2) of this section is in addition to the total mileage limitation of eight thousand six hundred (8,600) 9 10 miles that is set out in Section 65-3-3. 11 (2) The following highways are designated as a state highway and is placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi 12 13 Transportation Commission for maintenance; and such highways, 14 together with the highways designated in Sections 65-3-3 and 15 65-3-5 and all other laws adding links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be the state highway system of 16 Mississippi: 17 <u>Central District - Jefferson County:</u> 18 Those portions of Mississippi Highway 28 and U.S. 19 Highway 61 in Jefferson County that were maintained 20 prior to July 1, 2000, by the City of Fayette and 21 22 Jefferson County. The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall 23 (3) maintain, construct, take over and assume jurisdiction of the 2.4 25 highways designated in subsection (2) of this section in the same 26 manner and upon the same terms and conditions as set out in Sections 65-1-75, 65-3-3, 65-9-1 and 65-9-3. 27
