HOUSE BILL NO. 1409 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO ESTABLISH A
VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION TRACK AS AN ALTERNATIVE FOR
STUDENTS TO THE COLLEGE PREPARATORY CURRICULUM; TO PROVIDE THAT
STUDENTS IN THE VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION TRACK SHALL BE
REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE CORE CURRICULUM DEFINED BY THE STATE
BOARD OF EDUCATION AND MAY EARN ADDITIONAL CREDITS FOR
PARTICIPATION IN COOPERATIVE EDUCATION PROGRAMS; AND FOR RELATED
PURPOSES.

- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 10 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The school board of a local school district,
- 11 in its discretion, may establish and implement a vocational and
- 12 technical education track in the high schools in that district as
- 13 an alternative to the college preparatory curriculum. The purpose
- 14 of a vocational and technical education track established pursuant
- 15 to this section shall be to provide those students who do not
- 16 intend to pursue a traditional college education with skills and
- 17 training that will lead to gainful employment in a trade or
- 18 vocation.
- 19 (2) Students who participate in the vocational and technical
- 20 education track shall be required to complete the core curriculum
- 21 defined by the State Board of Education. In addition, a student
- 22 in the vocational and technical education track may be awarded
- 23 credit for an additional four (4) high school units earned through
- 24 the track, which units shall apply toward, and must be recognized
- 25 by the State Board of Education in fulfillment of, the local
- 26 school district's graduation requirements. Units may be awarded
- 27 in the vocational and technical education track for participation
- 28 in a cooperative education program, whereby a student gains actual
- 29 work experience in his chosen field through employment in a job

- 30 approved by the local school district. The local school district
- 31 shall adopt policies governing the participation of students in a
- 32 cooperative education program.
- 33 (3) Students successfully completing a vocational and
- 34 technical education track established pursuant to this section are
- 35 entitled to diploma evidencing graduation from a high school in
- 36 Mississippi.
- 37 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 38 and after July 1, 2000.
