9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
10	SECTION 1. The following words and phrases shall have the
11	meaning ascribed herein unless the context clearly indicates

13	(a) "College" means The Mississippi State
14	University College of Veterinary Medicine.
15	(b) "Committee" means the Rural Veterinarian
16	Incentive Program Committee established by this act.
17	(c) "Eligible participant" means a person eligible

52 <u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) A community or political subdivision located 53 in a rural county that qualifies under the rules of the committee 54 may become a sponsor of an eligible participant and may provide 55 financial support to the eligible participant under the program.

76 (2) To participate as a sponsor in the program, the 77 community or political subdivision must enter into an agreement 78 with the eligible participant to provide financial support to the 79 eligible participant in an amount not less than the tuition and fees required for a full academic year for a student enrolled in 80 the college in exchange for the eligible participant's agreement 81 82 to practice veterinary medicine in the sponsoring community or 83 political subdivision.

98 (3) Financial support from the fund shall be awarded in99 the form of grants.

100 <u>SECTION 7.</u> (1) The Rural Veterinarian Incentive Fund is
101 created as a special fund in the State Treasury.

102 (2) The fund consists of any legislative appropriations
103 for purposes of the program, gifts, grants, donations, the market
104 value of in-kind contributions and other sources of revenue
105 deposited to the credit of the fund by the university.

106 (3) The fund shall be administered by the university in 107 accordance with rules adopted by the committee. The university 108 may use a portion of the money deposited to the credit of the 109 fund, not to exceed ten percent (10%) of that amount, for the 110 administration of the program.

111 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 112 and after July 1, 2000.
