## HOUSE BILL NO. 1441

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE TAX COMMISSION MAY NOT PREPARE OR ISSUE ANY DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAG OR PLATE AUTHORIZED 3 BY THE LEGISLATURE AT THE 2000 REGULAR SESSION OR ANY LEGISLATIVE SESSION THEREAFTER, UNLESS THE ORGANIZATION OR OTHER ENTITY FOR 5 WHICH THE LEGISLATURE AUTHORIZED THE DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAG OR PLATE SUBMITS PROOF TO THE TAX COMMISSION THAT A CERTAIN MINIMUM NUMBER OF SUCH LICENSE TAGS OR PLATES WILL BE PURCHASED AND 6 7 8 DEPOSITS WITH THE COMMISSION AN AMOUNT NECESSARY TO PURCHASE THAT MINIMUM NUMBER; TO PROVIDE THAT IF THE NUMBER OF DISTINCTIVE 9 10 LICENSE TAGS OR PLATES FALLS BELOW THE MINIMUM NUMBER IN THE LAST YEAR OF THE SERIES, THE LICENSE TAG OR PLATE SHALL BE DISCONTINUED, BUT A DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAG DECAL MAY BE PREPARED 11 12 AND SOLD BY THE ORGANIZATION OR ENTITY; TO PROVIDE THAT THE 13 14 PROCEEDS DERIVED FROM THE SALE OF SUCH DECALS SHALL BE RETAINED BY 15 THE ORGANIZATION OR ENTITY FOR ANY USE DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE 16 ORGANIZATION OR ENTITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 18 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) For any distinctive license tag or plate authorized by the Legislature at the 2000 Regular Session of the 19 Legislative or any Legislative Session thereafter, including any 20 distinctive license tag or plate authorized under the provisions 21 of House Bill No. \_\_\_\_, 2000 Regular Session, the requirements of 22 23 this section must be met before the State Tax Commission may prepare or issue any such license tag or plate. The organization 24 25 or other entity for which the Legislature authorized the 26 distinctive license tag or plate must submit proof satisfactory to the State Tax Commission that at least one hundred (100) of such 27 28 license tags or plates will be purchased and must deposit with the 29 commission an amount necessary to purchase one hundred (100) of 30 such license tags or plates. The organization or other entity for 31 which the Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or 32 plate must satisfy the requirements of this subsection (1) within two (2) years after the effective date of the law authorizing the 33

- 34 license tag or plate in order to permit the license tag or plate
- 35 to be prepared and issued.
- 36 (2) If the organization or other entity for which the
- 37 Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or plate meets
- 38 the requirements of subsection (1) of this section, the State Tax
- 39 Commission shall prepare and issue the distinctive license tag or
- 40 plate. If the State Tax Commission prepares and issues a
- 41 distinctive license tag or plate for the organization or other
- 42 entity, the commission shall review the number of such license
- 43 tags or plates issued during the period for the license tag or
- 44 plate series. If the number of distinctive license tags or plates
- 45 falls below one hundred (100) in the last year of the series, the
- 46 license tag or plate shall be discontinued at the end of the
- 47 period for the series.
- 48 (3) If a distinctive license tag or plate is discontinued
- 49 under subsection (2) of this section, the organization or other
- 50 entity for which the license tag or plate was discontinued may
- 51 prepare a distinctive license tag or plate decal. The distinctive
- 52 license tag or plate decal shall be of such size, color and design
- 53 as may be agreed upon by the organization or other entity and the
- 54 State Tax Commission. However, the State Tax Commission shall
- 55 have final approval of the size, color and design of the decal.
- 56 The distinctive license tag or plate decals shall be prepared and
- 57 sold by the organization or other entity, and the proceeds derived
- 58 from the sale of such decals shall be retained by the organization
- 59 or other entity for any use deemed appropriate by the organization
- 60 or other entity.
- 61 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 62 and after July 1, 2000.
