HOUSE BILL NO. 1449 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN SEGMENT OF MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY
468 IN RANKIN COUNTY AS A STATE HIGHWAY AND PLACE IT UNDER THE
JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR
CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE IF NECESSARY RIGHTS-OF-WAY ARE
PROVIDED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT; TO PROVIDE THAT THE MISSISSIPPI
TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION SHALL PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE ENGINEERING
AND CONSTRUCTION OF FOUR LANES, OR FIVE LANES IF NEEDED, ALONG
SUCH SEGMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 10 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The mileage of highway specifically
- 11 designated in subsection (2) of this section is in addition to the
- 12 total mileage limitation of eight thousand six hundred (8,600)
- 13 miles that is set out in Section 65-3-3.
- 14 (2) The following highway is designated as a state highway
- 15 and is placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
- 16 Transportation Commission for construction and maintenance if the
- 17 City of Flowood and Rankin County provide necessary rights-of-way,
- 18 including utility adjustments and movements:

19 Central District-Rankin County:

- That two-lane portion of Mississippi Highway 468 beginning at
- 21 Fourth Street in Flowood and extending to Mississippi Highway 468,
- 22 a distance of approximately two and two-tenths (2.2) miles.
- 23 (3) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall
- 24 provide funds for the engineering services and construction of
- 25 four (4) lanes (or five (5) lanes where needed) along such
- 26 segment. The road shall be built to the design standards of the
- 27 Mississippi Department of Transportation.
- 28 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 29 and after July 1, 2000.
