HOUSE BILL NO. 1449
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN SEGMENTS OF HIGHWAY IN RANKIN
2 COUNTY AS STATE HIGHWAYS AND TO PLACE SUCH SEGMENTS UNDER THE
3 JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR
4 CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE; TO AUTHORIZE THE MISSISSIPPI
5 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CONSTRUCT A FOUR-LANE FACILITY
6 ALONG SUCH SEGMENTS CONDITIONED UPON THE LOCAL POLITICAL
7 SUBDIVISIONS PROVIDING NECESSARY RIGHTS-OF-WAY, INCLUDING UTILITY
8 ADJUSTMENTS AND RELOCATIONS; TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN ADDITIONAL
9 SECTION OF HIGHWAY IN JONES COUNTY AS A PART OF THE STATE HIGHWAY
10 SYSTEM AND TO PLACE IT UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI
11 TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION; TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN ADDITIONAL
12 SEGMENT OF HIGHWAY IN NEWTON COUNTY AS A PART OF THE STATE HIGHWAY
13 SYSTEM AND TO PLACE IT UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI
14 TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION; TO DELETE TWO SEGMENTS OF HIGHWAY IN
15 NEWTON COUNTY FROM THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM AND TO RETURN THEM TO
16 THE JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF NEWTON; TO AUTHORIZE THE
17 MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CONSTRUCT TO FOUR
18 LANES FOR HIGHWAY TRAFFIC A CERTAIN PORTION OF OLD U.S. HIGHWAY 45
19 IN THE CITY OF MERIDIAN AND LAUDERDALE COUNTY; TO DESIGNATE A
20 CERTAIN SEGMENT OF MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 25 IN MONROE COUNTY AS THE
21 "MONROE COUNTY PARKWAY"; TO AUTHORIZE THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT
22 OF TRANSPORTATION TO LANDSCAPE THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF SUCH SEGMENT;
23 TO PROHIBIT THE CONSTRUCTION OR ERECTION OF ANY ADVERTISEMENT OR
24 ADVERTISEMENT SIGN WITHIN 1,000 FEET OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF SUCH
25 SEGMENT AND TO PROVIDE CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS THERETO; TO REQUIRE
26 MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 25 TO INTERSECT WITH U.S. HIGHWAY 278 AT A
27 CERTAIN POINT WITHIN THE CITY OF AMORY; TO AUTHORIZE THE
28 MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CONSTRUCT A CONNECTOR
29 FROM OLD MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 25 AT OR NEAR THE CITY LIMITS OF
30 AMORY TO NEW MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 25; TO AMEND SECTION 65-37-13,
31 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DELAY FOR ONE YEAR THE BEGINNING OF
32 THE EIGHT-YEAR PERIOD DURING WHICH THE LEGISLATURE IS REQUIRED
33 EACH YEAR TO APPROPRIATE GENERAL FUND REVENUES TO THE LOCAL SYSTEM
34 BRIDGE REPLACEMENT AND REHABILITATION FUND; TO AUTHORIZE MONIES IN
35 THE LOCAL SYSTEM BRIDGE REPLACEMENT AND REHABILITATION FUND,
36 SUBJECT TO CERTAIN LIMITATIONS, TO BE CREDITED TO A COUNTY IN
37 ADVANCE OF NORMAL ACCRUAL; TO AMEND SECTION 65-3-3, MISSISSIPPI
38 CODE OF 1972, TO RECOMPILE THE SECTIONS OF LAW THAT LIST AND
39 DESCRIBE THOSE HIGHWAYS AND HIGHWAY SEGMENTS THAT COMPRISE THE
40 DESIGNATED STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM; TO RECODIFY AS A NEW SECTION
41 65-3-71.51, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, THAT PORTION OF CHAPTER 471,
42 LAWS OF 1996, DESIGNATING A CERTAIN ROUTE IN PIKE COUNTY AS THE
43 "HERSHAL L. GRADY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY"; TO REPEAL SECTIONS 65-3-5,
44 65-3-7, 65-3-9, 65-3-11, 65-3-13, 65-3-15, 65-3-17, 65-3-19,
45 65-3-21, 65-3-23, 65-3-25, 65-3-27, 65-3-33, 65-3-37, 65-3-72,
46 65-3-73, 65-3-74, 65-3-75, 65-3-76, 65-3-77, 65-3-78, 65-3-79,
47 65-3-81, 65-3-83, 65-3-85, 65-3-87, 65-3-89, 65-3-91, 65-3-93,
48 65-3-95, 65-3-101, 65-3-103, 65-3-105, 65-3-107, 65-3-109,

51 CODE OF 1972, WHICH ADD AND DELETE CERTAIN HIGHWAY SEGMENTS TO AND
52 FROM THE DESIGNATED STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM; AND FOR RELATED
53 PURPOSES.

55 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

56 SECTION 1. (1) The following highway is designated as a
57 state highway and is placed under the jurisdiction of the
58 Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and
59 maintenance when the City of Flowood provides necessary
60 rights-of-way, including utility adjustments and relocations:

61 Central District - Rankin County:

62 Mississippi 468 - That two-lane portion of Mississippi
63 468 (Flowood Drive) beginning at Fourth Street in
64 Flowood and extending northeasterly to Mississippi
65 Highway 475, a distance of approximately two and
66 two-tenths (2.2) miles.

67 (2) The segment described in subsection (1) of this section
68 shall be a four-lane facility built to the design standards of the
69 Mississippi Department of Transportation.

70 SECTION 2. (1) The Mississippi Department of Transportation
71 shall number, maintain, take over and assume jurisdiction of the
72 following described highway segment, subject to the conditions
73 prescribed in subsection (2) of this section.

74 Central District - Rankin County:

75 West Rankin Parkway (New Route) - Beginning at
76 Mississippi 25 in the City of Flowood, thence south to
77 U.S. 80 at Pearson Road in the City of Pearl, all in
78 Rankin County.

79 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation may
80 construct the highway segment described in subsection (1) of this
81 section as a four-lane facility in accordance with current design
82 standards; however, the City of Flowood, the City of Pearl, Rankin
83 County and any private corporation jointly shall provide necessary
84 engineering and rights-of-way, including utility adjustments and

85 relocations.

86 SECTION 3. The following highway is designated as a state
87 highway and is placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
88 Transportation Commission for construction and maintenance; and
89 such highway, together with the highways designated in Section
90 65-3-3, and all other laws adding links to the designated state
91 highway system, are declared to be the state highway system of
92 Mississippi:

93 Southern District - Jones County:

94 Mississippi 590 - Beginning at Mississippi 11 and extending
95 easterly to Mississippi 29, a distance of approximately 1.3
96 miles.

97 SECTION 4. (1) The following highway is designated as a
98 state highway and is placed under the jurisdiction of the
99 Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and
100 maintenance; and such highway, together with the highways
101 designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding links to
102 the designated state highway system, are declared to be the state
103 highway system of Mississippi:

104 Central District - Newton County:

105 Decatur Street beginning on the north side of the
106 intersection of Third Street and Decatur Street, and
107 proceeding northward to the beginning of state
108 maintenance south of U.S. Highway 80, all within the
109 City of Newton.

110 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall
111 maintain, construct, take over and assume jurisdiction of the
112 highway designated in subsection (1) of this section in the same
113 manner and upon the same terms and conditions as set out in
114 Sections 65-1-75, 65-9-1 and 65-9-3. However, the City of Newton
115 shall not be required to provide to the Mississippi Department of
116 Transportation any right-of-way with a width any greater than the
117 width of right-of-way that existed at the time that the highway

118 segment described in subsection (1) of this section was returned
119 to the jurisdiction of the City of Newton.

120 SECTION 5. The following highways are deleted from the state
121 highway system, removed from the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
122 Transportation Commission and returned to the jurisdiction of the
123 governing authorities of the City of Newton:

124 Central District - Newton County:

125 (a) That section of old Mississippi 15 beginning south
126 of Interstate 20 at the intersection of old Mississippi
127 15 and present Mississippi 15 and extending
128 southwesterly for approximately .033 miles, all within
129 the City of Newton; and

130 (b) That section of old Mississippi 15 located between U.S.
131 Highway 80 and Decatur Street, all within the City of Newton.

132 SECTION 6. (1) The Mississippi Department of Transportation
133 may construct to department design standards, may perform such
134 reconstruction as may be required to existing highways and may
135 acquire by gift, purchase or eminent domain proceedings such
136 property as may be necessary to provide four (4) lanes for traffic
137 on and along the following location:

138 Central District - Lauderdale County:

139 Old U.S. Highway 45 beginning in the City of Meridian at
140 or near the old Coca Cola Company and extending
141 northerly approximately two (2) miles to just beyond the
142 Town of Marion.

143 (2) Lauderdale County, the City of Meridian and the Town of
144 Marion shall provide required right-of-way, remove all
145 encroachments and bring up to Transportation Department standards
146 existing roads and bridges along the route described in subsection
147 (1) of this section.

148 (3) The mileage of highway specifically designated in
149 subsection (1) of this section shall be under the jurisdiction of
150 the Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and

151 maintenance and, together with the highways designated in Section
152 65-3-3, and all other laws adding links to the state designated
153 highway system, are declared to be the state highway system of
154 Mississippi.

155 SECTION 7. (1) (a) That portion of Mississippi Highway 25
156 from south of Becker, Mississippi, to the Monroe/Itawamba County
157 line shall be known as the "Monroe County Parkway."

158 (b) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall
159 erect and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching that
160 portion of Mississippi Highway 25 described in this subsection.

161 (2) The portion of Mississippi Highway 25 described in
162 subsection (1) of this section shall be constructed by the
163 Mississippi Department of Transportation as a fully-controlled
164 access road. The Mississippi Department of Transportation is
165 authorized to landscape the right-of-way of the portion of
166 Mississippi Highway 25 described in subsection (1) of this
167 section.

168 (3) It shall be unlawful to construct or erect any
169 advertisement or advertising structure within one thousand (1,000)
170 feet of the right-of-way of the portion of Mississippi Highway 25
171 described in subsection (1) of this section. This subsection
172 shall not apply to areas located within a municipality or to
173 signs, displays or devices located on a building which carry only
174 advertisements strictly related to the lawful use of the building.

175 (4) Mississippi Highway 25 shall intersect with U.S. Highway
176 278 at least five hundred (500) feet west of the eastern city
177 limits of the City of Amory as such city limits existed on January
178 1, 2000.

179 (5) The Mississippi Department of Transportation is
180 authorized to construct a four-lane connector road at a point at
181 or near the northern city limits of the City of Amory between old
182 Mississippi Highway 25 and the portion of Mississippi Highway 25
183 described in subsection (1) of this section.

184 SECTION 8. Section 65-37-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
185 amended as follows:

186 65-37-13. (1) There is created in the State Treasury a
187 special fund to be designated as the "Local System Bridge
188 Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund." The fund shall consist of
189 such monies as the Legislature appropriates pursuant to subsection
190 (2) of this section and such other monies as the Legislature may
191 designate for deposit in the fund. Monies in the fund may be
192 expended upon legislative appropriation in accordance with the
193 provisions of Sections 65-37-1 through 65-37-15.

194 (2) (a) During each regular legislative session held in
195 calendar years 1995, 1996, 1997 and 1998, if the official General
196 Fund revenue estimate for the succeeding fiscal year for which
197 appropriations are being made reflects a growth in General Fund
198 revenues of three percent (3%) or more for that succeeding fiscal
199 year, then the Legislature shall appropriate Twenty-five Million
200 Dollars (\$25,000,000.00) from the State General Fund for deposit
201 into the Local System Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund.

202 (b) During the regular legislative session held in
203 calendar year 1999, if the official General Fund revenue estimate
204 for the succeeding fiscal year for which appropriations are being
205 made reflects a growth in General Fund revenues of two percent
206 (2%) or more for the succeeding fiscal year, then the Legislature
207 shall appropriate Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) from the
208 State General Fund for deposit into the Local System Bridge
209 Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund.

210 (c) During each regular legislative session held in
211 calendar years 2001 through 2008, if the official General Fund
212 revenue estimate for the succeeding fiscal year for which
213 appropriations are being made reflects a growth in General Fund
214 revenues of two percent (2%) or more for the succeeding fiscal
215 year, then the Legislature shall appropriate Twenty Million
216 Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) from the State General Fund for deposit

217 into the Local System Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund.

218 (3) Such monies as are deposited in the fund under the
219 provisions of this section may be expended upon requisition
220 therefor by the State Aid Engineer in accordance with the
221 provisions of Sections 65-37-1 through 65-37-15. The Office of
222 State Aid Road Construction shall be entitled to reimbursement
223 from monies in the fund, upon requisitions therefor by the State
224 Aid Engineer, for the actual expenses incurred by the office in
225 administering the provisions of the local system bridge
226 replacement and rehabilitation program. Unexpended amounts
227 remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse
228 into the State General Fund, and any interest earned on amounts in
229 the fund shall be deposited to the credit of the fund.

230 (4) Monies in the Local System Bridge Replacement and
231 Rehabilitation Fund shall be allocated and become available for
232 distribution to counties in accordance with the formula prescribed
233 in Section 65-37-4 beginning January 1, 1995, on a
234 project-by-project basis. Monies in the Local System Bridge
235 Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund may not be used or expended
236 for any purpose except as authorized under Sections 65-37-1
237 through 65-37-15.

238 (5) Monies in the Local System Bridge Replacement and
239 Rehabilitation Fund may be credited to a county in advance of the
240 normal accrual to finance certain projects, subject to the
241 approval of the State Aid Engineer and subject further to the
242 following limitations:

243 (a) That the maximum amount of such monies that may be
244 advanced to any county shall not exceed ninety percent (90%) of
245 the funds estimated to accrue to such county during the remainder
246 of the term of office of the board of supervisors of such county;

247 (b) That no advance credit of funds will be made to any
248 county when the unobligated balance in the Local System Bridge
249 Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund is less than One Million

250 Dollars (\$1,000,000.00); and

251 (c) That such advance crediting of funds be effected by
252 the State Aid Engineer at the time of the approval of the plans
253 and specifications for the proposed projects.

254 It is the intent of this provision to utilize to the fullest
255 practicable extent the balance of monies in the Local System
256 Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund on hand at all times.

257 SECTION 9. Section 65-3-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
258 amended as follows:

259 65-3-3. The following highways are * * * designated as state
260 highways and shall be * * * under the jurisdiction of the
261 Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and
262 maintenance, * * * and such highways, along with all other laws
263 adding links to the designated state highway system, are declared
264 to be the state highway system of Mississippi:

265 Mississippi 1--Begins at Onward, Sharkey County, thence in a
266 westerly direction to Filer, thence in a northerly direction to
267 Mayersville, thence continues from Mississippi 14 approximately
268 mid-way between Mayersville and Rolling Fork to or near
269 Greenville, Rosedale, Sherard and ends at U.S. 49 east of
270 Mississippi River Bridge at Helena, Coahoma County.

271 Mississippi 2--Begins at or near Hickory Flat, Benton County,
272 and extends in a northeasterly direction to or near Blue Mountain,
273 thence continues from or near Ripley to or near Kossuth to U.S. 72
274 west of Corinth, thence from U.S. 45 north of Corinth, Alcorn
275 County, northeasterly to the Mississippi-Tennessee state line.

276 Mississippi 3--Begins at a point on U.S. 61 at or near
277 Redwood, Warren County, and extends in a northeasterly direction
278 to or near Satartia and Yazoo City, thence follows U.S. 49W to or
279 near Inverness, thence in a northeasterly direction to Moorhead,
280 thence north to Sunflower, thence continues along U.S. 49W to
281 Tutwiler, thence in a northeasterly direction to Lambert, Marks,
282 Sledge, Crenshaw, Sarah and Savage to intersect U.S. 61 at or near

283 Lake Cormorant, DeSoto County.

284 Mississippi 4--Begins at or near Fox Island and extends east
285 to or near Tunica, Coahoma County, thence continues from U.S. 61
286 south of Tunica to or near Savage, Strayhorn, Senatobia, Holly
287 Springs, and Ashland, thence continues from Mississippi 5
288 approximately six and one-half miles south of Ashland to or near
289 Ripley, Booneville, Bentonite Mill, Livingstons Store, New Site,
290 and Bay Springs to Mississippi 25 at or near Dennis.

291 Mississippi 5--Begins on Mississippi 178 near Hickory Flat,
292 Benton County, and extends north to Elvis Chapel Church on U.S.
293 72, and thence west on U.S. 72 to Harris Chapel Church and thence
294 northwest to Mississippi 7, Benton County.

295 Mississippi 6--Begins on Mississippi 161 in Clarksdale,
296 thence easterly to Marks, Batesville, Oxford, Pontotoc, Tupelo,
297 thence southerly to Nettleton and ends at or near Amory.

298 Mississippi 7--Begins at or near Belzoni, Humphreys County,
299 and extends in a northeasterly direction to or near Swiftown to
300 U.S. 82 north of Itta Bena, thence continues from or near
301 Greenwood to or near Holcomb, Grenada, Coffeeville, Water Valley,
302 Oxford and Holly Springs to the Mississippi-Tennessee state line
303 northeast of Michigan City, Benton County.

304 Mississippi 8--Begins on Mississippi 1 at or near Rosedale,
305 Bolivar County, and extends in an easterly direction to or near
306 Cleveland, Ruleville, Minter City, Philipp and Holcomb, thence
307 continues from or near Grenada to or near Calhoun City, Houston
308 and Aberdeen and ends on U.S. 278 at or near Greenwood Springs,
309 Monroe County.

310 Mississippi 9--Begins at or near Ackerman, Choctaw County,
311 and extends in a northerly direction to or near Eupora,
312 Bellefontaine and Slate Springs to Mississippi 8 south of Calhoun
313 City, thence continues from or near Calhoun City to or near Bruce,
314 Sarepta, Pontotoc and Sherman, thence continuing from U.S. 78
315 northwest of Sherman to, at or near Blue Springs and ending at

316 Mississippi 30 at or near Graham, Union County.

317 Mississippi 9W--Begins on Mississippi 9 north of Bruce,
318 Calhoun County, and extends northerly to or near Banner and Paris
319 to Mississippi 7 at Airport Road south of Markette, Lafayette
320 County.

321 I-10--From the Mississippi-Louisiana state line east of
322 Slidell, Louisiana, to the Mississippi-Alabama state line
323 southwest of Mobile, Alabama.

324 U.S. 11--Begins on I-59 at or near Nicholson, south of
325 Picayune, Pearl River County, and extends in a northeasterly
326 direction to or near Picayune, Poplarville, Hattiesburg, Laurel,
327 Enterprise and Meridian, and thence easterly to the
328 Mississippi-Alabama state line, Lauderdale County.

329 Mississippi 12--Begins on Mississippi 1 at or near James,
330 Washington County, thence continuing through LeRoy Percy State
331 Park and extends in an easterly direction to or near Hollandale,
332 Belzoni, Tchula, Lexington, Durant, Kosciusko and Ackerman to a
333 point on U.S. 82 north of Mississippi State University, thence
334 continues from or near Columbus and extends in a northeasterly
335 direction to the Mississippi-Alabama state line, Lowndes County.

336 Mississippi 13--Begins at a point on U.S. 49 at or near
337 Maxie, Forrest County, and extends in a northwesterly direction to
338 or near Lumberton and Columbia, thence continues in a northerly
339 direction to or near Prentiss, Mendenhall, Puckett, Daniel,
340 Polkville, Morton and Lena and ends at a point on Mississippi 16
341 west of Carthage at or near Pine Tree, Leake County.

342 Mississippi 14--Begins at or near Mayersville, Issaquena
343 County, and extends in an easterly direction to or near Rolling
344 Fork, thence continues from U.S. 61 at or near Anquilla to U.S.
345 49W at or near Louise, thence continues from, at or near Ebenezer
346 to or near Goodman, Newport and Zemuly to south of Kosciusko to or
347 near Louisville and Macon ending at the Mississippi-Alabama state
348 line east of Macon, Noxubee County.

349 Mississippi 15--Begins at the intersection of I-10 and I-110,
350 Harrison County, and extends in a northerly direction to or near
351 Beaumont, Laurel, Bay Springs, Newton, Philadelphia, Louisville,
352 Ackerman, Mathiston, Houston, Pontotoc, New Albany, Ripley, Walnut
353 and ends at the Mississippi-Tennessee state line, Tippah County.

354 Mississippi 16--Begins on Mississippi 1 at or near the
355 Issaquena-Washington county line, thence in a southeasterly
356 direction to Rolling Fork and extends in a southeasterly direction
357 near Little Sunflower River, thence continues from or near Holly
358 Bluff in a northeasterly direction to U.S. 49W at or near Craig,
359 thence continues from or near Yazoo City to or near Benton to U.S.
360 51 at or near Canton, thence continues to or near Carthage,
361 Philadelphia, Dekalb and Scooba to the Mississippi-Alabama state
362 line east of Scooba, Kemper County.

363 Mississippi 17--Begins in Scott County on designated
364 Mississippi 25, thence northerly to Mississippi 16 near Farmhaven,
365 thence to or near Pickens, Lexington, Carrollton and ends
366 approximately three and one-tenth miles northeast of North
367 Carrollton, Carroll County.

368 Mississippi 18--Begins at or near Grand Gulf, Claiborne
369 County, then to or near Port Gibson and extends in a northeasterly
370 direction to or near Hermanville, Utica and Raymond to an
371 intersection with U.S. 80 at or near Jackson, thence from Brandon
372 continues in a southeasterly direction to or near Raleigh and Bay
373 Springs, thence continues in a northeasterly direction to or near
374 Rose Hill, thence southeast to or near Pachuta, thence east to or
375 near Quitman and ends at the Mississippi-Alabama state line east
376 of Quitman, Clarke County.

377 Mississippi 19--Begins on U.S. 51 at or near West, Holmes
378 County, and extends in a southeasterly direction to or near
379 Kosciusko, Zama, Arlington High School, Yates Crossing,
380 Philadelphia and Meridian, and ends at the Mississippi-Alabama
381 state line southeast of Meridian, Lauderdale County.

382 I-20--From the Mississippi-Louisiana state line at Vicksburg
383 to a point on I-55 in Jackson and from another point on I-55
384 southeast of Jackson to a point on I-59 west of Meridian.

385 Mississippi 21--Begins at a point on Mississippi 35 at or
386 near Forest, Scott County, and runs in a northeasterly direction
387 to or near Sebastopol, Dixon, Neshoba County Fairgrounds,
388 Philadelphia, Bond High School, Preston, Gholson, thence in a
389 northeasterly direction to intersect Mississippi 39 at or near

798 or near Walnut, all in Tippah County.

799 Mississippi 370--Begins at Mississippi 5 at or near Ashland,
800 Benton County, thence easterly to Mississippi 15 at or near
801 Falkner, thence from Mississippi 4 at or near Ripley southeasterly
802 to or near Dumas thence to Mississippi 30 at or near Pleasant
803 Ridge, thence from Mississippi 30 east of Pleasant Ridge to or
804 near Baldwyn and ends at Mississippi 371 at or near Kirkville,
805 Itawamba County.

806 Mississippi 371--Begins on Mississippi 6 south of Nettleton,
807 Monroe County, thence north to or near Richmond and Mooreville,

816 and extends northward to a point on Mississippi 371 near

818 Mississippi 382--Begins on U.S. 45A and thence runs in an
819 easterly direction through Prairie to intersect Mississippi 25
820 approximately three miles south of Aberdeen, all in Monroe County.

821 Mississippi 385--Begins at or near Buena Vista and runs in a
822 northwesterly direction to Mississippi 32 at or near Van Vleet,
823 all in Chickasaw County.

824 Mississippi 388--Begins at or near Brooksville and extends
825 east to or near Cliftonville and to the Mississippi-Alabama state
826 line, all in Noxubee County.

827 Mississippi 389--Begins on U.S. 82 in Starkville, Oktibbeha
828 County, and runs in a northwesterly direction to the
829 Oktibbeha-Clay county line, thence to a point on Mississippi 46 at
830 Montpelier, continues in a northerly direction to a point on
831 Mississippi 8 in Houston, Chickasaw County.

832 Mississippi 391--Begins at the east side of T. N. Kinard
833 property line and runs in a northeasterly direction to
834 Winston-Noxubee county line, all in Winston County.

835 Mississippi 393--Begins on the Winston-Neshoba county line
836 and extends northward to Mississippi 490 at or near Claytown,
837 Winston County.

838 Mississippi 395--Begins on Mississippi 19 at or near
839 Arlington, Neshoba County, and runs north to Plattsburg, thence
840 east to or near Noxapater, Winston County.

841 Mississippi 397--Begins at or near Louisville, Winston
842 County, and extends southeast to or near DeKalb, Kemper County.

843 Mississippi 403--Begins at or near Mathiston and extends

844 north and west to the county highway maintenance barn for District
845 No. 4 in Webster County.

846 **Mississippi 404**--Begins at I-55 in Carroll County and extends
847 east to U.S. 51 north of Duck Hill, thence from a point on U.S. 51
848 at Duck Hill in an easterly direction to beat line of Beat No. 2
849 in Montgomery County and from the intersection of
850 Cadaretta-Bellefontaine Road at Spring Hill, and extends easterly
851 to or near Bellefontaine in Webster County.

852 **Mississippi 407**--Begins on U.S. 51, Montgomery County, thence
853 in a southeasterly direction to Mississippi 413 at French Camp,

893 Mississippi 433--Begins on U.S. 61 at or near Kelso, Sharkey
894 County, thence northeast to a point south of Spanish Fort, and
895 thence from, at or near Satartia, east to or near Bentonia, thence
896 in a northerly direction to or near Benton, and thence to a point
897 approximately four miles north of the Holmes-Yazoo county line.

898 Mississippi 434--Begins on U.S. 61 north of Anquilla and
899 extends east to or near Catchings, now Delta City, all in Sharkey
900 County.

901 Mississippi 436--Begins at or near Glen Allen and extends
902 northeasterly to U.S. 61 at or near Percy, all in Washington
903 County.

904 Mississippi 438--Begins at or near Wayside, Washington
905 County, and extends to the Washington-Humphreys county line.

906 Mississippi 440--Begins on Mississippi 19 in Section 2,
907 Township 15 North, Range 5 East, thence easterly to intersect
908 Mississippi 35 at Hesterville, all in Attala County.

909 Mississippi 442--Begins at Mississippi 448 one mile east of

910 Shaw, Sunflower County, thence in an easterly direction to
911 Steiner, thence in a northerly direction to Linn, thence in an
912 easterly direction to Doddsville and extends easterly to U.S. 49E
913 near Schalter, Leflore County.

914 Mississippi 444--Begins at Mississippi 1 at or near Round
915 Lake in Bolivar County, thence easterly to intersect U.S. 61 at or

917 Mississippi 446--Begins at Mississippi 1 at or near Lobdell

930 Gibson, thence in a northerly direction to a point at or near
931 Willows, being a part of road connecting U.S. 61 and Mississippi
932 27 formerly Mississippi 3, all in Claiborne County.

933 Mississippi 463--Begins on Mississippi 22 at or near

944 or near Brandon, all in Rankin County.

945 Mississippi 469--Begins on Mississippi 28 at or near Fork
946 Church, Simpson County, thence northerly to Harrisville, Florence
947 and extends northeasterly to intersect Mississippi 468, Rankin
948 County.

949 Mississippi 471--Begins at or near Brandon and extends in a
950 northerly direction to Mississippi 25, thence from a point seven
951 and five-tenths miles northeast on Mississippi 25 to intersect

1053 near Pineville to U.S. 80 in Forest.

1054 Mississippi 502--Begins with its intersection with
1055 Mississippi 488 between Standing Pine and Free Trade, thence in an
1056 easterly direction by Springfield Baptist Church, Thaggards
1057 Clinic, Madden School and intersects Mississippi 488 at Madden
1058 Baptist Church in the Village of Madden, all in Leake County.

1059 Mississippi 503--Begins on Mississippi 528 at or near
1060 Heidelberg, Jasper County, thence in a northerly direction to

1606 Mississippi 913--Spur--Begins on Mississippi 24, now
1607 Mississippi 33 in East Gloster, and extends west to Liberty Road,
1608 Amite County.

1609 Mississippi 915--Mississippi 42 and Mississippi 43
1610 Connection--Begins on Jones Street and runs between Mississippi 43
1611 and Mississippi 42, in the Town of New Hebron, Lawrence County.

1612 Mississippi 917--Mississippi 18 Loop--Begins at the
1613 intersection of Mississippi 18 at or near the Sylvarena Masonic
1614 Lodge and makes what is known as the Sylvarena Loop, coming back
1615 into Mississippi 18 at or near the residence of Will Houston, all
1616 in Smith County.

1617 Mississippi 923--Mississippi 584 Spur--Begins on Mississippi
1618 584 in the southeast corner of Amite County east of Gillsburg and
1619 extends southeast to the Louisiana-Mississippi state line.

1620 Mississippi 927--Spur--Begins on Mississippi 906 east of
1621 Summit and extends north to Southwest Community College, Pike
1622 County.

1623 Mississippi 928--U.S. 65 Spur--Begins on U.S. 65 in Natchez
1624 and extends north on Homochitto Street, Adams County.

1625 Mississippi 930 and 932--Begin on U.S. 61 North in Adams
1626 County, in the vicinity of the weighing scales and proceed
1627 therefrom to the intersection of Melrose Avenue and East Franklin
1628 Street.

1629 Mississippi 937--U.S. 84 Spur--Begins on U.S. 84 in south
1630 Prentiss and extends north on Columbia Avenue to the railroad
1631 crossing, all in Jefferson Davis County.

1632 Mississippi 938--Begins at the northwest corner of new
1633 Mississippi Transportation Department District Office site and
1634 extends easterly to U.S. 51 approximately forty-five
1635 one-hundredths mile north of the north corporate limits of the

1636 City of McComb, Pike County.

1637 Mississippi 946--Mississippi 24 Spur--Begins on Mississippi
1638 24, now Mississippi 33, Amite County, and extends northwest to
1639 Centreville, Wilkinson County.

1640 Mississippi 952--Mississippi 513 Spur--Begins on Mississippi
1641 513 and extends north to U.S. 11 in Enterprise, Clarke County.

1642 Mississippi 967--U.S. 49 Spur--Begins on Mississippi 42 in
1643 north Hattiesburg and extends south on Main Street, all in Forrest
1644 County.

1645 Mississippi 969--Spur--Begins on U.S. 49 approximately 2.84
1646 miles south of U.S. 11, and extends north on Edwards Street
1647 approximately .83 miles, all in Hattiesburg, Forrest County.

1648 Mississippi 975--Begins on U.S. 90 at Cowan Road in Gulfport,
1649 thence in a northerly direction along Cowan and Lorraine Roads to
1650 I-10, thence in a northwesterly direction to North Swan Road and
1651 ends on U.S. 49 at or near Lyman for a distance of approximately
1652 12 miles, all in Harrison County.

1653 Mississippi 977--A central Harrison County connector from
1654 I-10 to U.S. 90 in the vicinity of Canal Road to the Mississippi
1655 State Port at Gulfport.

1656 Mississippi 979--An east Harrison County connector from U.S.
1657 90 to I-10 to be located between the Cowan-Lorraine Road
1658 interchange and the I-110 interchange, thence northerly to
1659 relocated/reconstructed Mississippi 67.

1660 Mississippi 981--Lorraine-Cowan Road Extension from I-10
1661 north to relocated/reconstructed Mississippi 67, thence
1662 northwesterly to relocated Mississippi 67 at or near U.S. 49, all
1663 in Harrison County.

1664 Mississippi 991--Spur, also known as Singing River Island
1665 Causeway--extends south to Naval Station, all in Jackson County.

1666 Mississippi 992--Mississippi 43 Spur--Begins on Mississippi
1667 43 northwest of Picayune and extends south to Picayune, Pearl
1668 River County.

1669 Mississippi 993--Begins at Litton Industries, Inc., between
1670 West Pascagoula River and East Pascagoula River in the City of
1671 Pascagoula and extends north to U.S. 90, all in Jackson County.

1672 Mississippi 994--Mississippi 613 Spur--Begins on Mississippi
1673 613 in Moss Point and extends east to U.S. 90 at Orange Grove,
1674 Jackson County.

1675 SECTION 10. The following shall be codified as Section
1676 65-3-71.51, Mississippi Code of 1972:

1677 65-3-71.51. (1) Mississippi 908, a route providing direct
1678 access from the interchange at I-55 at or near Summit to Southwest
1679 Community College, is designated and shall be known as the
1680 "Hershal L. Grady Memorial Highway."

1681 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
1682 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching such highway.

1683 SECTION 11. Sections 65-3-5, 65-3-7, 65-3-9, 65-3-11,
1684 65-3-13, 65-3-15, 65-3-17, 65-3-19, 65-3-21, 65-3-23, 65-3-25,
1685 65-3-27, 65-3-33, 65-3-37, 65-3-72, 65-3-73, 65-3-74, 65-3-75,
1686 65-3-76, 65-3-77, 65-3-78, 65-3-79, 65-3-81, 65-3-83, 65-3-85,
1687 65-3-87, 65-3-89, 65-3-91, 65-3-93, 65-3-95, 65-3-101, 65-3-103,
1688 65-3-105, 65-3-107, 65-3-109, 65-3-111, 65-3-113, 65-3-115,
1689 65-3-117, 65-3-119, 65-3-121, 65-3-123, 65-3-125, 65-3-127,
1690 65-3-129 and 65-3-131, Mississippi Code of 1972, which add and
1691 delete certain highway segments to and from the designated state
1692 highway system, are repealed.

1693 SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from
1694 and after its passage.
