## HOUSE BILL NO. 1455

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 7-7-42, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE 1 2 3 AND ADMINISTRATION SHALL TRANSFER THE FUNDS FROM THE CANCELLATION 4 OF STATE OF MISSISSIPPI WARRANTS ISSUED AFTER JANUARY 1, 2000, TO 5 THE ABANDONED PROPERTY FUND OF THE UNCLAIMED PROPERTY DIVISION OF THE STATE TREASURY; TO PROVIDE THAT IF THE FUNDS REMAIN UNCLAIMED FOR FIVE YEARS, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER THE FUNDS BACK 6 7 TO THE ORIGINAL SOURCE OF THE FUNDS; TO AMEND SECTIONS 89-12-14 8 AND 89-13-37, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY THERETO; AND 9 10 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 12 SECTION 1. Section 7-7-42, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 13 amended as follows:[HS1]

14 7-7-42. Any State of Mississippi warrant issued by the Executive Director of the Department of Finance and Administration 15 against any fund in the State Treasury which has not been 16 presented to the State Treasurer for payment within one (1) year 17 after the last day of the month in which it was originally issued, 18 shall be null and void, the obligation thereafter shall be 19 20 unenforceable and the Executive Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall not issue an additional warrant. 21 22 23 The Executive Director of the Department of Finance and Administration is authorized and directed to cancel all 24 25 outstanding warrants over one (1) year old at the end of each month and shall notify the State Treasurer who shall remove such 26 27 warrants from his list of outstanding warrants. \* \* \* 28 The Executive Director of the Department of Finance and

29 Administration shall transfer the funds reflected by the

30 cancellation of the warrant to the Abandoned Property Fund

After five (5) years, if the funds are unclaimed, the 33 State Treasurer shall transfer the funds back to the original 34 35 source of funds. 36 This section is applicable to warrants issued on and after 37 January 1, 2000. SECTION 2. Section 89-12-14, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 38 39 amended as follows: 40 89-12-14. (1) All intangible property, including, but not limited to, any interest, dividend, or other earnings thereon, 41 less any lawful charges, held by a business association, federal, 42 43 state or local government or governmental subdivision, agency or entity, or any other person or entity, regardless of where the 44 holder may be found, if the owner has not claimed or corresponded 45 in writing concerning the property within five (5) years after the 46 date prescribed for payment or delivery, is presumed abandoned and 47 subject to the custody of this state as unclaimed property if: 48 The last known address of the owner is unknown; and 49 (a) 50 The person or entity originating or issuing the (b) intangible property is this state or any political subdivision of 51 52 this state, or is incorporated, organized, created or otherwise 53 located in this state. The provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall 54 (2) 55 not apply to property that is or may be presumed abandoned and 56 subject to the custody of this state pursuant to any other

57 provision of law containing a dormancy period different than that 58 prescribed in subsection (1) of this section.

59 (3) The provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall 60 apply to all property held at the time of the effective date of 61 this section, or at any time thereafter, regardless of when such 62 property became or becomes presumptively abandoned.

(4) Insofar and only insofar as funds reflected by the
 cancellation of State of Mississippi warrants are unclaimed and
 presumed abandoned, the State Treasurer shall transfer such funds
 out of the Abandoned Property Fund established by Section 89-12-37
 to the original fund source after the expiration of five (5) years

69 SECTION 3. Section 89-12-37, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 70 amended as follows:

89-12-37. (1) All funds received under the provisions of 71 72 this chapter shall forthwith be deposited by the Treasurer in a special fund hereby established in the State Treasury to be 73 74 designated the "Abandoned Property Fund," except that the 75 Treasurer shall deposit in a separate special fund hereby 76 established in the State Treasury to be designated the "Abandoned 77 Property Claims Payment Fund" an amount not exceeding One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) from which he shall make 78 79 prompt payment of claims duly allowed by him as hereinafter 80 provided. Before making the deposits in either special fund, he shall record the name and last known address of each person 81 appearing from the holders' reports to be entitled to the 82 83 abandoned property and the name and last known address of each 84 insured person or annuitant and, with respect to each policy or contract listed in the report of a life insurance corporation, its 85 86 number, the name of the corporation and the amount due. The 87 record shall be available for public inspection at all reasonable 88 business hours.

There is created within the Abandoned Property Fund in 89 (2)90 the State Treasury a trust to be known as the Historic Properties Financing Fund, which shall be used as provided in this section. 91 On July 1, 1999, Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) in the 92 93 Abandoned Property Fund shall be set aside and placed in the Historic Properties Financing Fund created herein. The principal 94 95 of the Historic Property Financing Fund shall remain inviolate within the Abandoned Property Fund, and shall be invested in the 96 97 same manner as the remainder of the Abandoned Property Fund. The 98 interest and income earned from the investment of the principal of the Historic Properties Financing Fund shall be transferred 99 100 quarterly to the Mississippi Landmark Grant Program account within

102 The transferred money shall be utilized by the Department of
103 Archives and History for the purposes as specified in Section
104 39-5-23(3).

(3) Notwithstanding subsections (1) and (2) of this section, 105 106 the funds reflected by the cancellation of State of Mississippi warrants that constitute part of the Abandoned Property Fund shall 107 108 be transferred by the State Treasurer back to the original fund source if unclaimed by the owner within the time specified in 109 110 Section 7-7-42 as amended by House Bill No. , 2000 Regular 111 Session. SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 112

113 and after its passage.
