> 3 AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW CODE SECTION TO REQUIRE THE 4COMMISSIONER OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO 5ESTABLISH A TOLL FREE HOTLINE IN ALL STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES 6FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECEIVING COMPLAINTS OF ALLEGED SEXUAL 7MISCONDUCT COMMITTED AGAINST FEMALE OFFENDERS BY CORRECTIONAL 8OFFICERS OR STAFF MEMBERS; TO PROVIDE THE FUNCTIONS OF THE 9HOTLINE; TO REQUIRE THE COMMISSIONER TO PUBLICIZE THE EXISTENCE OF 10THE HOTLINE SERVICE TO ALL FEMALE OFFENDERS; TO REQUIRE THE 11COMMISSIONER TO APPOINT A FIVE MEMBER INDEPENDENT INVESTIGATIVE 2BOARD FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING THE VALIDITY OF THE ALLEGED 13SEXUAL MISCONDUCT; TO PROVIDE THAT ALL TELEPHONE CALLS PLACED TO 14THE HOTLINE SHALL BE FREE FROM MONITORING BY THE PRISON OFFICIALS; 15 TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS PROVISION; AND FOR 16RELATED PURPOSES.

> 17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

18 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Commissioner of the Mississippi

19Department of Corrections shall establish a toll free hotline in

20all state correctional facilities for the purpose of receiving

21 complaints of alleged sexual misconduct committed against female 22offenders by staff members of the department. For purposes of 23this section, "hotline" means a direct telephone line to one (1) 24or more licensed social workers employed by the department. (2) The individual(s) answering the hotline shall: 25 26 (a) Provide offenders with information about their 27rights and about nongovernmental organizations that they may 28 contact for assistance; 29 (b) Forward verified complaints to the Chairman of the 30 Senate Corrections Committee, the Chairman of the Penitentiary 31Committee of the House of Representatives and the State Attorney 32General;

33 (c) Ensure the confidentiality of all calls received 34and any written correspondence emerging from an offender's contact 35with the hotline; and

36 (d) Maintain an accurate compilation of all data

37 collected through the hotline for investigative purposes.

38 (3) The Commissioner shall publicize the existence of the 39hotline to all female offenders.

40 (4) The Commissioner of the Mississippi Department of 41Corrections shall appoint a five (5) member independent internal 42investigative board solely for the purpose of administering the 43hotline program and determining the validity of the alleged sexual 44abuse of female inmates.

(5) Officers and staff members of the department alleged to 46have engaged in sexual misconduct with an offender shall be 47assigned to a position which does not require physical contact 48with offenders until completion of the investigation. Upon 49completion of the investigation, the officer or staff member shall 50be notified and a hearing held in compliance with the personnel 51policy and procedures of the department. If sexual misconduct is 52determined to have occurred, the officer or staff member shall be 53 suspended or dismissed in accordance with the personnel policies 54 and procedures.

(6) All calls placed to the hotline shall be free from 56monitoring by prison officials. It shall be unlawful for any 57officer or employee of a correctional facility or agent of a 58provider of telecommunication services to monitor, intercept or 59otherwise interfere with any telecommunications associated with 60the use of the toll free hotline. Any person who violates this 61provision shall be guilty of a felony and upon conviction shall be 62fined not more than Four Thousand Dollars(\$4,000.00) or imprisoned 63for a term not to exceed four (4) years, or both.

64 (7) The Commissioner shall establish the toll free hotline65not later than December 31, 2000.

66 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall be codified as a 67separate code section in Title 47, Mississippi Code of 1972.

69and after July 1, 2000.
