## HOUSE BILL NO. 1495

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11-27-89, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM COMPENSATION AUTHORIZED TO BE PAID FOR
- 3 APPRAISALS IN CERTAIN EMINENT DOMAIN PROCEEDINGS; AND FOR RELATED
- 4 PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 11-27-89, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:[JWB1]
- 8 11-27-89. The appraiser shall receive as compensation for
- 9 his services such sum, plus expenses, as the court \* \* \* allow $\underline{s}$ ,
- 10 which shall be taxed as cost in the proceedings \* \* \*  $\frac{*}{.}$  The sum
- 11 allowed shall be based upon the degree of difficulty and the time
- 12 required to perform the appraisal, but may not exceed One Thousand
- 13 Dollars (\$1,000.00) unless, in the opinion of the court, special
- 14 <u>circumstances warrant a greater sum. An order granting a sum</u>
- 15 greater than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) must describe in
- 16 <u>detail the special circumstances that warrant payment of a greater</u>
- 17 <u>sum</u>.
- 18 The making of a deposit by the plaintiff or the withdrawal of
- 19 said deposit by the defendant or defendants shall not prejudice
- 20 the right of any party to a trial by jury in the special court of
- 21 eminent domain to determine the fair market value of the property
- 22 to be condemned and the damages, if any, to the remainder if less
- 23 than the whole is taken, as provided in Sections 11-27-1 through
- 24 11-27-49.
- 25 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 2000.
