- THE MANTACHIE NATURAL GAS DISTRICT AS THE NORTHEAST MISSISSIPPI
- 4 NATURAL GAS DISTRICT AND TO REMOVE THE LIMIT ON THE AMOUNT OF
- 5 REVENUE BONDS THAT THE DISTRICT MAY ISSUE; AND FOR RELATED
- 6 PURPOSES.

- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 1, Chapter 309, Laws of 1966, as amended
- 9 by Chapter 496, Laws of 1982, is amended as follows:
- 10 Section 1. The <u>Northeast Mississippi</u> Gas District is hereby
- 11 created, said district being composed of the following described
- 12 areas:
- 13 (a) All that part of Itawamba County, Mississippi,
- 14 lying west of the Tombigbee River;
- 15 (b) That portion of Lee County lying within one-half
- 16 (1/2) mile on either side of the center line of State Highway 363,
- 17 extending a distance of five (5) miles west from the county line
- 18 dividing Itawamba and Lee Counties;
- 19 (c) That portion of Lee County lying within one-half
- 20 (1/2) mile on either side of the center line of U.S. Highway 78,
- 21 extending a distance of five (5) miles west from the county line
- 22 dividing Itawamba and Lee Counties, and the unincorporated
- 23 community of Mooreville in Lee County; and
- 24 (d) That portion of Lee County lying within one-half
- 25 (1/2) mile on either side of the center line of State Highway 371
- 26 (being the highway from Mantachie to Mooreville), extending a
- 27 distance of five (5) miles southwest from the county line dividing
- 28 Itawamba and Lee Counties.

- SECTION 2. Section 2, Chapter 309, Laws of 1966, as amended
- 30 by Chapter 496, Laws of 1982, is amended as follows:
- 31 Section 2. The said <u>Northeast Mississippi</u> Gas District shall
- 32 be and is hereby declared to be a valid political subdivision of
- 33 the State of Mississippi, with the power to sue and be sued and to
- 34 contract and be contracted with.
- 35 SECTION 3. Section 4, Chapter 309, Laws of 1966, as amended
- 36 by Chapter 496, Laws of 1982, is amended as follows:
- 37 Section 4. From and after the effective date of this act,
- 38 the powers of the <u>Northeast Mississippi</u> Gas District shall be
- 39 vested in and exercised by a board of commissioners consisting of
- 40 three (3) residents of the district. The Governor shall appoint
- 41 an interim board, the term of which shall expire upon completion
- 42 of the construction of the district's natural gas transmission and
- 43 distribution system and the election of a successor board as
- 44 hereinafter provided.
- 45 Promptly upon the commencement of natural gas service by the
- 46 district to not less than ten (10) individually billed users, the
- 47 commissioners shall give notice to each user of an initial
- 48 election to be held at a time not less than thirty (30) days nor
- 49 more than sixty (60) days from such date. The notice shall state
- 50 the time, place, and manner in which the users may vote upon the
- 51 selection of the board to terms of one (1), two (2) and three (3)
- 52 years by ballot of all users of the district. Such election shall
- 53 be held in a manner and according to procedures to be established
- 54 by rules and regulations adopted by the board prior to the giving
- of notice of such election, and a printed copy of such rules and
- 56 regulations shall accompany the notice to be forwarded by regular
- 57 mail to the users.
- Rules and regulations for the conduct of the election shall
- 59 provide for a method of nomination of commissioners, notice of
- 60 such nominations to be provided to users not less than ten (10)
- 61 days prior to the date upon which the election is to be held,

- 62 along with a method of balloting by mail as well as personal
- 63 attendance at the time and place of election, a method of
- 64 balloting by proxy vote, and a method of making additional
- 65 nominations by users in addition to any nominations proposed by
- 66 the board of commissioners. The time of the election shall be
- 67 fixed between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on a day of
- 68 the week other than Sunday.
- In this and all succeeding elections, each user of the
- 70 district shall have one (1) vote; provided that when a billing is
- 71 made to more than one (1) person at a single location, each such
- 72 person shall be limited to casting a pro rata share of the one (1)
- 73 vote to which the billing location is entitled.
- 74 Subsequent to the initial election, there shall be held an
- 75 election annually on a date and in a manner substantially
- 76 conforming to the initial election, except that in each annual
- 77 election following the initial election, commissioners shall be
- 78 elected to terms of three (3) years.
- 79 Vacancies in the office of commissioner during the interim
- 80 period shall be filled by appointment of the Governor and,
- 81 following the holding of the initial election, shall be filled for
- 82 the unexpired term by the remaining commissioners.
- SECTION 4. Section 5, Chapter 309, Laws of 1966, as amended
- 84 by Chapter 496, Laws of 1982, is amended as follows:
- Section 5. The board shall have the power to make such rules
- 86 and regulations as it deems necessary to the operation of the
- 87 district and the subsequent election of commissioners and shall
- 88 possess, and is hereby granted all necessary power and authority
- 89 to construct, acquire, improve, repair and extend a natural gas
- 90 transmission and distribution system and to issue revenue bonds
- 91 <u>for such purposes</u>. Except as herein provided, all powers with
- 92 respect to natural gas transmission and distribution systems
- 93 granted to municipalities of this state by Sections 21-27-11
- 94 through 21-27-69, Mississippi Code of 1972, are hereby conferred

- 95 upon and may be exercised within the district by the board as if
- 96 the system and financing thereof as provided herein were pursuant
- 97 to said sections.
- 98 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 99 and after its passage.
