## HOUSE BILL NO. 1530

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 85-7-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 PROVIDE A LIEN FOR AGRICULTURAL AVIATORS FOR SERVICES RENDERED; 3 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 85-7-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

7 85-7-1. (1) Every employer shall have a lien on the share 8 or interest of his employee in any crop made under such 9 employment, for all advances of money, and for the fair market 10 value of other things advanced by him, or anyone at his request, 11 for supplies for himself, his family and business during the 12 existence of such employment, which lien the employer may offset, 13 recoup, or otherwise assert and maintain.

(2) Every employee, laborer, cropper, part owner, overseer 14 or manager, or other person who may aid by his labor to make, 15 gather, or prepare for sale or market any crop, shall have a lien 16 17 on the interest of the person who contracts with him for such labor for his wages, share or interest in such crop, whatever may 18 be the kind of wages or the nature of the interest, which lien 19 20 such employee, laborer, cropper, part owner, overseer or manager, or other person may offset, recoup or otherwise assert and 21 22 maintain.

(3) Except as provided in subsection (4) of this section,
any lien arising under the provisions of this section shall be
paramount to all liens and encumbrances or rights of any kind
created by or against the person so contracting for such

H. B. No. 1530 00\HR40\R1894 PAGE 1 27 assistance, except the lien of the lessor of the land on which the 28 crop is made, for rent and supplies furnished, as provided in the chapter on "Landlord and Tenant," appearing as Chapter 7 of Title 29 30 89, Mississippi Code of 1972.

31 (4) Any lien arising under the provisions of subsection (2) 32 of this section in favor of any person other than an employee, laborer, cropper, part owner, overseer or manager as to crops or 33 the proceeds thereof shall be effective against a third party only 34 for a period of twenty-one (21) days from and after the time the 35 labor is completed, unless within such period of time notice of 36 the lien is filed in the same manner as notices of security 37 interests in crops growing or to be grown are filed in accordance 38 39 with the provisions of Section 75-9-401, being a part of the Uniform Commercial Code. Any such lien in favor of any person 40 other than an employee, laborer, cropper, overseer or manager for 41 which notice has not been filed within the twenty-one-day period 42 as herein provided shall, upon a subsequent filing of the notice 43 44 of such lien, have the priority as against a third party to which a perfected security interest may be entitled under Chapter 9 of 45 46 Title 75, Mississippi Code of 1972.

47 (5) Every agricultural aviator shall have a lien on the 48 interest and property of the person who contracts with him for agricultural aviation services, which lien such agricultural 49 aviator may offset, recoup or otherwise assert and maintain. 50 51 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2000.

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
