HOUSE BILL NO. 1548
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO NAME THE NEW ARCHIVES AND HISTORY BUILDING TO BE
2 LOCATED IN JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 SECTION 1. The new Archives and History Building to be
5 located on the corner of Amite Street and North Street in Jackson,
6 Mississippi, shall be named the William F. Winter Archives and
7 History Building.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
9 and after its passage.
