HOUSE BILL NO. 1555

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES'
2 RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING A COMPREHENSIVE
3 STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF PROVIDING ONE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM
4 FOR ALL RETIRED PUBLIC EMPLOYEES, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2001.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be
7 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
8 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Public Employees'
9 Retirement System for the purpose of conducting a comprehensive
10 study of the feasibility of providing one (1) health insurance
11 program for all retired public employees, for the fiscal year
12 beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....\$40,000.00.

13 SECTION 2. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
14 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund
15 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State
16 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his
17 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or
18 officers in the manner provided by law.

19 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
20 and after July 1, 2000.
