6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. In addition to all other sums previously
8	appropriated, the following sum, or so much of it as may be
9	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the special fund in
LO	the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of Archives and
L1	History, to be deposited in the Historic properties Trust Fund
L2	(Fund No. 3476) in the State Treasury for the period beginning
L3	upon the passage of this act and ending June 30, 2001
L4	\$2,800,000.00.
L5	This additional appropriation is for the purpose of matching
L6	funds for acquisition of nationally significant battlefields under
L7	Section 131 of the federal fiscal year 1999 Interior and Related
L8	Agencies Appropriations Act. These funds shall be used by the
L9	Department of Archives and History to assist counties,
20	municipalities and Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3)
21	tax-exempt nonprofit organizations in acquiring significant Civil
22	War battlefield sites through the acquisition of fee simple title
23	or perpetual preservation easements, or in retiring the debt
24	incurred in purchasing those properties. Any remaining funds may
25	be used by the Department of Archives and History for the
26	preservation of Civil War properties within the state upon the
27	recommendation of the Mississippi Civil War Battlefield

- 28 Commission.
- The Department of Archives and History may accept and expend
- 30 any grant, donation or contribution from any individual, public or
- 31 private organization or governmental entity for the project
- 32 authorized in this act. Such grants, donations or contributions
- 33 shall be received and expended under the rules and regulations of
- 34 the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner
- 35 consistent with the escalation of federal funds.
- 36 SECTION 2. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
- 37 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund in the
- 38 State Treasury upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer,
- 39 and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon
- 40 requisitions signed by the property person officer or officers in
- 41 the manner provided by law.
- 42 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 43 and after its passage.
