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| 4 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be |
| 6 | necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State |
| 7 | General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of |
| 8 | defraying the expenses of the Department of Archives and History |
| 9 | for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending |
| 10 | June 30, 2001\$ 8,528,335.00. |
| 11 | SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be |
| 12 | necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special |
| 13 | fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of |
| 14 | Archives and History which is comprised of special source funds |
| 15 | collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the |
| 16 | purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal |
| 17 | year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001 |
| 18 | \$ 2,158,982.00. |
| 19 | SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of |
| 20 | Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below |

| 43 | With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of |
| 44 | the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to |

| 47 | funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions |

- 71 History is hereby authorized to accept and expend any grant,

- 73 organization, or government entity for purposes of defraying the
- 74 operational costs of the department. Such grants, donations or
- 75 contributions shall be received and expended under the rules and
- 76 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a
- 77 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.
- 78 SECTION 5. It is the intent of the Legislature that the
- 79 Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the
- 80 maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with
- 81 the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these
- 82 charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the
- 83 State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of
- 84 Archives and History.
- 85 SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that no part
- 86 of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for
- 87 the payment of rent for the museum and public space in the State
- 88 Historical Museum, Old Capitol Restoration.
- 89 SECTION 7. In addition to all other sums herein
- 90 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 91 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds from the Local
- 92 Government Records Fund in the State Treasury to defray the cost

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Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended exceed the unexpended balances of June 30, 2000.

SECTION 11. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2000.
